1. Bible doctrine is defined as Bible teachings arranged in a systematic form.
2. The "Statement of Fundamental Truths" is a document outlining the basic beliefs of the Assemblies of God.
3. If we accept that there is error in the salvation message of the Bible it casts doubt on the existence and character of God.
4. Natural law cannot be the standard for righteous living because the human race is fallen and cannot be righteous by nature alone.
5. Natural law and human philosophy are two secular belief systems that do not accept any religious faith or doctrine.
6. What makes the Bible different from all other books in the world is that it is divinely inspired and free from error.
7. The baptism in the Holy Spirit is one of the cardinal doctrines of the Assemblies of God.
8. Human philosophy opposes God by elevating human reason above the rules given by a God.
9. Atheistic evolution teaches that God does not actually exist.
10. The best evidence that God really exists is seen in the orderly universe and world around us that must have had a Creator.
11. Pride was the first sin committed by Satan in heaven.
12. To believe that Jesus is the divine son of God is a requirement of salvation.
13. Satan's temptation of Adam and Eve spoke true facts but did not tell all of God's truth.
14. Adam and Eve were real people who were the original ancestors of the human race.
15. Even *white lies* that do not seem to hurt anyone destroy the foundation of our relationship with God.
16. When we say God is omnipotent, we are saying he is all powerful.

17. When we say humans are created with a free will, we mean we have a choice in our eternal destiny.
18. Justification means that after one is saved, one recognizes that all past sins are forgiven.
19. When we say Jesus was both human and divine, we affirm that he was all human and all divine.
20. Old Testament prophecy predicted Jesus's birth.
21. The fact that the new creation will ultimately be better than the original creation is God's redemptive plan.
22. Christ's resurrection is essential to our faith because without the resurrection the miracle of salvation would lack its power.
23. The process of sanctification, or progressive sanctification, takes place throughout the believer's entire lifetime beginning with salvation.
24. The reason Jesus had to die as a sacrifice for our sins was because without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.
25. Christ's suffering for our salvation was predicted by Isaiah.
26. The most important truth of our Christian faith is salvation.
27. Newly converted Christians should observe the ordinance of water baptism as soon after salvation as feasible.
28. Christ's command was to baptize in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
29. Predestination is the term for the belief that God has already determined who will be saved and who will not be saved.
30. Christ's atoning work at Calvary is commemorated by the Lord's Supper.
31. "Total depravity" is the first point in the Calvinistic TULIP acrostic.
32. Jesus assured his followers their salvation was secure when he said, "No one can snatch them out of my hand or my Father's hand."

33. Apostasy, as described in Hebrews 6:4-6, is defined as turning one's back on Christ after having tasted the heavenly gift.
34. Calvinists believe that God in the eternal past determined who would be saved.
35. Water baptism by immersion is a testimony that one has received Jesus Christ as personal Savior.
36. The Old Testament feast of Passover is replaced by the Lord's Supper.
37. The Holy Spirit is at work today wherever the true Church is found.
38. Pentecostals who do not believe in the Trinity are called "Jesus only" churches.
39. The best biblical proof of the Trinity is found in the account of Jesus's baptism by John.
40. The process of becoming more and more like Jesus is known as progressive sanctification.
41. Legalism as a means of righteous living is defined as required obedience to religious law or a moral code.
42. A genuine mark of spiritual maturity is moving from self-centered concerns to ministry and concern for others.
43. Holiness is properly defined as an obedient heart that seeks to please God in every action.
44. We do not believe that Spirit Baptism and speaking in tongues are required for salvation, yet we do believe that we should obey the biblical command to be filled with the Spirit.
45. Initial evidence and devotional tongues (prayer language) are utterances in tongues that are normally not interpreted.
46. Daily communion with the Lord, praying in the Spirit, and walking in the Spirit are things a Spirit filled believer should do to keep his or her experience current and strong.
47. Often a delay in receiving the baptism in the Holy Spirit is caused by self-consciousness rather than God consciousness.
48. Peter says that the events of the Day of Pentecost were a fulfillment of Joel 2:28-29.

49. If a person fears having committed the unpardonable sin, he or she should know that such a person would have no desire to be forgiven, and so, ask for forgiveness.
50. 1 Corinthians 12: 8-10 includes a list of spiritual gifts.
51. The Bible contrasts the fruit of the Spirit with the works of the flesh or sinful nature.
52. Self-control is the fruit of the Spirit that regulates and binds together all the other fruit.
53. Prophecy is the gift or ministry of the Spirit included in all four Bible passages.
54. The gift of prophecy is always an utterance of divine truth in a person's own language.
55. A Spirit filled Christian knows he or she is experiencing spiritual growth when the fruit of the Spirit are more in evidence in his or her life.
56. The purpose of the Gifts of the Spirit is to edify and build up the church.
57. If a Christian's priorities are not the same as God's priorities they will fail to be effective witnesses.
58. Concerning modern-day apostles, the Assemblies of God believes that apostolic ministries are active, but persons do not assume the title.
59. The gift of generous giving means bountiful giving of money, possessions, and self beyond the tithes.
60. When Jesus referred to the Holy Spirit as the Paraclete, he meant one who comes alongside to help.
61. When one is used by the spirit in supernatural gifting it is important for that person to keep an attitude of humility.
62. All believers are called to be witnesses even though not all believers have the gift of the evangelist.
63. Paul identifies the church as the body of Christ and the body of the individual believer as "the Temple of the Holy Spirit".
64. Witnessing is defined as telling others about our love for Jesus and what he has done for us.

65. Pentecostals understand "groans that words cannot express" to mean praying in the Spirit.
66. On the Day of Pentecost the "Age of the Spirit" began.
67. When we pray in the Spirit, the Holy Spirit intercedes for us with the Father.
68. The Holy Spirit is described in Scripture as our teacher and guide.
69. All those who are living a Spirit filled life constitute the great Fellowship of the Holy Spirit.
70. Cessationism is defined as the belief that the gifts of the Spirit, including healing, ended with the first century.
71. When we say that Satan is the agent of sickness, we mean that sickness is part of the sin curse Satan has brought on this world.
72. The secular world has a closed mind and refuses to accept the reality of supernatural miracles and thus does not believe in divine healing.
73. Every person who is healed eventually dies because God has declared that physical death is the end waiting for every person.
74. One of the best reasons to believe that Jesus heals today is that healing is provided in Christ's Atonement.
75. In seeking the Lord for healing, one should consider doctors and medicine to be a means God may use in granting healing.
76. Demon powers can inflict limited suffering, but they cannot possess and control a true believer.
77. Pentecostal churches are sometimes called "Full Gospel" which means, all the gospel, especially salvation, spirit baptism, healing, and second coming.
78. We develop the moment by moment communion with Jesus for healing by guarding our time to meditate on Jesus through reading God's word.
79. Inner healing involves deliverance from abnormal fears and mental or emotional distress.
80. The biblical pattern for appropriating our healing is to call for the spiritual leaders of the church to pray for our healing.

81. Positive confession, in relation to healing, is a false doctrine claiming what a person says determines what he or she receives; name it and you can claim it.
82. The redemption of our physical bodies will take place at the Rapture.
83. The entire Christian community is important to a person's healing because when one member suffers, the whole body suffers and helps bear the burden.
84. Healthy believers should relate to the sick and suffering by sharing God's love, not His judgment.
85. Placing your complete trust and confidence in God's faithfulness is the best way for the believer to handle unanswered prayer for healing.
86. At the Rapture the dead in Christ will be raised first, then those who are alive.
87. As end time signs announce the soon return of Christ for his followers, we must work harder to win the lost.
88. According to Peter, Jesus delays his coming because God is patient and desires more people to come to repentance.
89. The Assemblies of God teaches that we will be saved from the Great Tribulation by a pre-Tribulation Rapture.
90. The Second Coming, which is distinct from the Rapture, occurs after the Tribulation.
91. The Assemblies of God, like most Pentecostal groups, is premillennialist.
92. The "Kingdom Now" belief teaches that the world is now being made into Christ's perfect kingdom.
93. The "sin that so easily entangles" is unbelief and related sins like failure to mature in Christ.
94. The "Day of the Lord" begins with the Rapture.
95. The seal, trumpet, and bold judgments of the Tribulation are God's judgment of the unbelieving and ungodly humankind.
96. The "Wedding Supper of the Lamb" and the "Judgment Seat of Christ" happen in heaven during the Tribulation.

97. The Great White Throne Judgment is the saddest scene in the Bible because the wicked dead will be resurrected, judged, and cast into the lake of fire.
98. Seven Angels are the creatures that will blow the seven trumpets announcing more judgments.
99. There have been many antichrists, but the Antichrist of Revelation will be the embodiment of evil in the Tribulation.
100. After his brief release to make his final effort to deceive people, Satan will be cast into the lake of fire permanently.
