The following is a response to Mr. Ramuth's request for a course-by-course evaluation of his academic credentials from Brazil. This evaluation was prepared based on official original credentials.

Mr. Ramuth attended the Faculty of Medical Sciences of Santa Casa of Sao Paulo (*Faculdade de Ciencias Médicas da Santa Casa de Sao Paulo*) from 1979 to 1984. Founded in 1963, the Faculty of Medical Sciences of the Santa Casa of Sao Paulo is a private institution of higher education accredited by the Ministry of Education of Brazil. In order to be admitted into the Faculty of Medical Sciences of the Santa Casa of Sao Paulo, applicants must have the Certificate of Completion of Secondary Education (*Certificado de Conclusao de 2o. Grau*) and pass the entrance examination. This is the equivalent of graduation from a college preparatory program at an accredited high school in the United States.

In Brazil, as well as in most countries in the world, students enter the school of medicine directly after high school graduation. The six-year medical program consists of the pre-medical, pre-clinical and clinical programs.

Mr. Ramuth completed the six-year medical program and graduated with the degree of Physician (Medico) from the Faculty of Medical Sciences of the Santa Casa de Sao Paulo on December 21, 1984. This is the equivalent of the U.S. degree of Doctor of Medicine earned at a regionally accredited institution of higher education in the United States. Mr. Ramuth did not request that we calculate his grade point average.




This evaluation is of an advisory nature. Each institution will decide which of the above mentioned courses will transfer.
