OSHA's Bloodborne Pathogens Standard:

Bloodborne pathogens are infectious microorganisms present in blood that can cause disease in humans. These pathogens include, but are not limited to, hepatitis B virus (HBV), hepatitis C virus (HCV), and human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), the virus that causes AIDS. Workers exposed to bloodborne pathogens are at risk for serious or life-threatening illnesses.

Staff were trained on the standards for universal precautions and were provided with the standards for their own review.


Staff were provided the opportunity to ask any questions and seek supervision regarding Universal precautions procedures.
