DRUG NAME Divalprole
GENERIC NAME divalproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE 125 mg, 250 mg, 500 mg
HOW TO TAKE Oral medication
USES Partial seizures, bipolar disorder, migraine
SIDE EFFECTS Somnolence, Coma, bleeding
WARNINGS Caution bleeding risk, jaundice, Caution if you have alcohol injury

DRUG NAME Flovent
GENERIC NAME fluticasone propionate
DOSAGE RANGE 44 mcg, 110 mcg, 220 mcg
HOW TO TAKE Inhaler
USES asthma
SIDE EFFECTS hoarseness, vomiting, rash
WARNINGS Caution if hepatic impairment, Immunosuppressant, active infection.

DRUG NAME Crestor
GENERIC NAME Rosuvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE 5mg, 10mg, 20mg, 40mg
HOW TO TAKE Oral medication
USES hypercholesterolemia, mixed hyperlipidemia
SIDE EFFECTS Abdominal pain, Dizziness, Insomnia
WARNINGS Caution if hypothyroidism, diabetes mellitus

DRUG NAME Lantus
GENERIC NAME insulin glargine
DOSAGE RANGE 100 units/ml
HOW TO TAKE Injection
USES Diabetes type 1 and 2
SIDE EFFECTS URI, weight gain, infection
WARNINGS Hypersens to drug/class/Concom

DRUG NAME Keppra
GENERIC NAME Levetiracetam
DOSAGE RANGE 250mg, 500mg, 750mg, 1000mg
HOW TO TAKE Oral tabs
USES Seizures
SIDE EFFECTS Decreased inhibitory, psychosis, Neurosis, Pain
WARNINGS Caution if pregnancy, Hypersens to drug/class/Concom

DRUG NAME Neerakate
GENERIC NAME Miralax
DOSAGE RANGE Polyethylene glycol 3350 0.4g/kg - 17g per day
HOW TO TAKE Oral Powder
USES Constipation
SIDE EFFECTS Nausea, Dizziness, abdominal distention
WARNINGS Caution if you have a GI obstruction, Ably Pts, Renal impairment

DRUG NAME Toprol-XL
GENERIC NAME Metoprolol succinate
DOSAGE RANGE 25mg, 50mg, 100mg, 200mg max 400mg per day
HOW TO TAKE Oral Tab
USES migraine headache, heart failure w/ reduction fracture, HLV, angina
SIDE EFFECTS Depression, Dizziness, Fatigue, Rash, Nightmares
WARNINGS Cardiogenic shock, sinus bradycardia, Heart failure, Uncompensated

DRUG NAME ~~Etanercept~~ Motrin
GENERIC NAME ~~Etanercept~~ Ibuprofen
DOSAGE RANGE 400mg - 800mg Chewable 200mg - 400mg
HOW TO TAKE Oral ~~Injection~~ - Chewable tab
USES ~~Psoriasis, Rheumatoid~~ Pain mild moderate
SIDE EFFECTS Nausea, Drowsiness, headache, GI bleeding, ulcers, stroke
WARNINGS

DRUG NAME Tylenol with Codeine
GENERIC NAME acetaminophen
DOSAGE RANGE 1-2 tabs
HOW TO TAKE Oral tab
USES Pain reducer
SIDE EFFECTS Anemia, headache, Nausea, Rash
WARNINGS Hx of liver disease / alcoholism, acute hepatic dz, Renal impairment

DRUG NAME Dilantin
GENERIC NAME Phenytoin
DOSAGE RANGE 50 cap 30mg, 100mg chewable 50mg
HOW TO TAKE Tab vs chewable tab
USES Seizure disorders
SIDE EFFECTS vomiting, Confusion, Constipation, Insomnia, blurred vision
WARNINGS Caution at pregnant, elderly, Drunk, depression
