GENERIC NAME	hydrocodone/acetaminophen
DOSAGE RANGE	5mg/325mg, 7.5mg/325mg, 10mg/325mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth (PO)
USES	Pain
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, sedation, vomiting, constipation, psychomotor impairment
WARNINGS	overdose, death, addiction, Abuse, REMS, Resp. Depression, accidental ingestion by children can be fatal, Hepatotoxicity.

DRUG NAME	Toprol-XL
GENERIC NAME	metoprolol succinate
DOSAGE RANGE	12.5mg - 400mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth (PO)
USES	Antianginals, Beta Blockers, Headache / Migraine
SIDE EFFECTS	nightmares, bradycardia, rash, fatigue, dizziness, dyspnea
WARNINGS	

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10mg - 80mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth (PO)
USES	Dyslipidemia: HMG-CoA Reductase Inhibitors (Statins)
SIDE EFFECTS	UTI, musculoskeletal pain, extremity pain, cognitive impairment
WARNINGS	No Black Box Warnings

DRUG NAME	Haladol
GENERIC NAME	haloperidol
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5mg - 20mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth (PO)
USES	Antipsychotics, 1st Gen. Tic Disorders / Tourette Syndrome
SIDE EFFECTS	lethargy, anxiety, impaired body temp. regulation, insomnia
WARNINGS	Dementia Related Psychosis

DRUG NAME	Ativan
GENERIC NAME	Lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5, 1mg, 2mg, 1NJ; 2mg per mL, 4mg per ML
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth (PO), intramuscular (IM) Intravenous (IV)
USES	Antiemetics, "benzos", Alcohol Dependence, Insomnia, Sedation, Seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	sedation, constipation, menstrual irregularities, dizziness, ataxia
WARNINGS	Addiction, Dependence, profound sedation, resp. depression, coma, death.

DRUG NAME	Clozaril
GENERIC NAME	Clozapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg, 100 mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Antipsychotics (schizophrenia, psychosis, depression, A 12
SIDE EFFECTS	weight gain, tachycardia, fever, tremor, visual disturbance
WARNINGS	Neutropenia, seizures, myocarditis, Dementia related Psychosis, cardiomyopathy, orthostatic hypotension.

DRUG NAME	Klonopin
GENERIC NAME	Clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5mg, 1mg, 2mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Seizure disorders, Tourette Syndrome, "Benzos", sleep related movement
SIDE EFFECTS	depression, incontinence, rash, confusion, amnesia, drowsiness
WARNINGS	Addiction, Abuse, profound resp. depression, coma, death, Dependence.

DRUG NAME	Levothyroxine
GENERIC NAME	Euthyrox, Levathroid, Levoxyl, Synthroid, Thyquidity, Tirospan
DOSAGE RANGE	13mg, 25, 50, 75, 88, 100, 112, 125, 137, 150, 175, 200, (Cap)
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth (PO) intravenous (IV) intramuscular (IM)
USES	Thyroid Disorders: Hypothyroidism
SIDE EFFECTS	heat intolerance, insomnia, anxiety, weight loss, palpitations
WARNINGS	Not for weight loss. life-threatening toxicity.

DRUG NAME	Depakote
GENERIC NAME	Divalproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	30mg - 500mg
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth (PO)
USES	Bi Polar disorder, Headache/Migraines, Seizure Disorders
SIDE EFFECTS	blurred vision, photosensitivity, vomiting, headache, diarrhea
WARNINGS	Hepa toxicity, Fetal Risk, Pancreatitis
