

DRUG NAME	Pnlosec
GENERIC NAME	omeprazole
DOSAGE RANGE	powder, tablet, capsule, packet
HOW TO TAKE	oral PO
USES	ulcers, GERD
SIDE EFFECTS	constipation, gas, nausea, diarrhea, vomiting, headache
WARNINGS	allergic reactions with antibiotics

DRUG NAME	Lisinopril
GENERIC NAME	Prinivil, Zestril
DOSAGE RANGE	tablet 10mg once a day
HOW TO TAKE	tablets, liquid
USES	treat high blood pressure, prevent strokes, heart attacks
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, headache, cough, excessive tiredness, heartburn
WARNINGS	low blood pressure, high blood potassium, kidney problems including kidney failure

DRUG NAME	Motrin
GENERIC NAME	Ibuprofen
DOSAGE RANGE	100-800mg, Capsule 200mg, Chewable 50-100mg
HOW TO TAKE	tablet, ^{100-800mg} Capsule 200mg, Tablet chewable 50-100mg
USES	pain reliever, fever reducer
SIDE EFFECTS	constipation, diarrhea, gas, bloating, dizziness, ringing in the ears
WARNINGS	tinnitus, heartburn, blurred vision, internal bleeding

DRUG NAME	Zyprexa
GENERIC NAME	danzapine
DOSAGE RANGE	2.5, 5, 7.5, 10, 15 mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO once a day tablet
USES	Schizophrenia, depression, anxiety, mental/mood conditions
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, dizziness, lightheadedness, stomach upset, dry mouth
WARNINGS	likely to get heat stroke if sweat less

DRUG NAME	Flexeril
GENERIC NAME	Cyclobenzaprine
DOSAGE RANGE	5mg tid capsule
HOW TO TAKE	swallow capsule whole
USES	muscle spasms, relax muscles
SIDE EFFECTS	dry mouth, headache, blurred vision, drowsiness, fatigue
WARNINGS	stomach pain

DRUG NAME	Ativan
GENERIC NAME	Lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	.5 mg, 1 mg, 2 mg; INJ 2 mg per mL, 4 mg per mL
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth (PO), (IM), (IV) bid-tid (2x-3x day)
USES	insomnia.
SIDE EFFECTS	Respiratory depression, apnea, respiratory failure, abuse, seizures
WARNINGS	Opioid-sedation, depression, coma, death Addiction, Abuse, mis-use Dependence, Withdrawal Reactions

DRUG NAME	Flonase
GENERIC NAME	fluticasone propionate nasal (allergy relief)
DOSAGE RANGE	1 squirt each nostril
HOW TO TAKE	squirt in nostril
USES	allergy relief relieves sneezing, runny nose, itchy nose, itchy eyes, watery eyes
SIDE EFFECTS	headaches, nausea, stomach pain ^{sore throat} , sneezing, cough, vomiting, cold-like symptoms
WARNINGS	minor nose bleed, burning + itching of nose, cough, trouble breathing sores or white patches inside or around your nose

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	Atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10 to 80 mg tablets
HOW TO TAKE	1 Tablet once a day with or without food
USES	reduce heart attack and stroke, cholesterol decrease, angina, heart disease
SIDE EFFECTS	headaches, nausea, diarrhea, cold-like symptoms
WARNINGS	Don't take while pregnant or breast feeding

DRUG NAME	Novolog
GENERIC NAME	insulin aspart
DOSAGE RANGE	is based on blood sugar levels
HOW TO TAKE	Flex-Pen, 3-mPenFill cartridge, 10 mL vial expires 28 days p opening
USES	control high blood sugar
SIDE EFFECTS	anxiety, irritability, mood changes, dizziness, sweating, confusion
WARNINGS	Pregnant, breast feeding, taking new drugs OTC meds including supplements, Don't take if blood sugar is too low, rotate injection sites

DRUG NAME	Dilantin
GENERIC NAME	Phenytoin
DOSAGE RANGE	tablet, Chewable, Suspension, Capsule, Extended Release
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	treat and prevent seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	headaches, drowsy, dizzy, nervous, shaky, unsteady, constipation
WARNINGS	overdose can lead to a coma, avoid alcohol, there are various medications you don't want to take w this
