GENERIC NAME	Lisinopril, Prilicor, Zestril
DOSE RANGE	2.5-40mg
HOW TO TAKE	ORAL
USES	Hypertension, Heart failure w/reduced ejection fraction
SIDE EFFECTS	Dizziness, Headache, Cough, Fatigue
WARNINGS	Renal Failure, Staph Angioedema Hypotension

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	Atorvastatin
DOSE RANGE	10-80mg
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	Cardiovascular event prevention, High lipid
SIDE EFFECTS	UTI, Diarrhea UTI, Headache
WARNINGS	Acute renal failure, Myopathy, Rhabdomyolysis

DRUG NAME	Flonase
GENERIC NAME	Fluticasone Propionate Nasal Spray
DOSE RANGE	1-2 actuations each nostril
HOW TO TAKE	Nasal
USES	Allergies
SIDE EFFECTS	Immunosuppression, Anaphylaxis, Nasal burning, Irritation
WARNINGS	Anaphylaxis, Hypersensitive w/other drugs, Untreated medical issues

DRUG NAME	Clozapin
GENERIC NAME	Clozapine
DOSE RANGE	300-450mg Day, 900 max
HOW TO TAKE	ORAL
USES	Schizophrenia, Suicide prevention
SIDE EFFECTS	Seizures, Stroke, weight gain, severe constipation
WARNINGS	Neutropenia, Seizures, Druggs

DRUG NAME	Ativan
GENERIC NAME	Lorazepam
DOSE RANGE	1-6mg Day
HOW TO TAKE	ORAL, IV, IM
USES	Anxiety, Insomnia, Alcohol withdrawal
SIDE EFFECTS	Hypotension, Seizures, Jaundice, Abuse
WARNINGS	Concomitant opioid use, ^{proprio} sedation, Abuse-OD, Death

DRUG NAME	HCTZ
GENERIC NAME	Hydrochlorothiazide
DOSE RANGE	50mg - 25mg
HOW TO TAKE	ORAL
USES	Hypertension, Peripheral Edema
SIDE EFFECTS	Dizziness, Blurred Vision, Sexual Dysfunction
WARNINGS	Fracture, Arthralgia, Anaphylaxis, Renal Failure

DRUG NAME	Topamax
GENERIC NAME	Topiramate
DOSE RANGE	25mg - 200mg
HOW TO TAKE	ORAL
USES	Partial Seizures, Primary Generalized Tonic-Clonic Seizure
SIDE EFFECTS	URI Dizziness, Nausea, Fever, Insomnia
WARNINGS	Psychosis, Anorexia, Withdrawal Seizures, Acute D/C

DRUG NAME	Colace
GENERIC NAME	Docusate Sodium
DOSE RANGE	50mg - 300mg
HOW TO TAKE	ORAL
USES	Laxative
SIDE EFFECTS	Diarrhea, Rash, Stool Thorp Irritation
WARNINGS	Electrolyte Disorders

DRUG NAME	Morco
GENERIC NAME	Hydrocodone / Acetaminophen
DOSE RANGE	2.5mg - 10mg
HOW TO TAKE	ORAL
USES	Pain Moderate, Severe
SIDE EFFECTS	Anaphylaxis, Skin Reaction, Hypotension, Central Stupor
WARNINGS	Overdose, Addiction, Withdrawal, Respiratory Depression

DRUG NAME	Toprol
GENERIC NAME	Metoprolol Succinate
DOSE RANGE	12.5mg - 400mg
HOW TO TAKE	ORAL
USES	Hypertension, Angina, Heart Failure, Reduced Estrogen Levels
SIDE EFFECTS	Fatigue, Dizziness, Diarrhea, Rash
WARNINGS	Low HR, Mod-Severe Heart Failure
