DOSAGE RANGE	12.5mg, 250mg, 500mg
HOW TO TAKE	capsule
USES	Seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	fever, vomiting, hr
WARNINGS	easy bruising

GENERIC NAME	tramadol
DOSAGE RANGE	D/C
HOW TO TAKE	capsul, tablet
USES	pain
SIDE EFFECTS	weak pulse
WARNINGS	itching
