GENERIC NAME	lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5mg - 2mg Tab .5mg - 2mg Tab 2mg Per mL - 4mg Per mL
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Anxiety insomnia or difficulty sleeping
SIDE EFFECTS	Sedation dizziness asthenia ataxia fatigue
WARNINGS	Aggression Confusion hallucinations

GENERIC NAME	Haloperidol
DOSAGE RANGE	.5mg Tabs - 20mg Tabs
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Schizophrenia, Tourettes
SIDE EFFECTS	Restlessness Drowsiness weight gain Headache
WARNINGS	Could cause Heart failure low blood sugar Seizure

DRUG NAME	Lithium
GENERIC NAME	Lithium
DOSAGE RANGE	150mg - 600mg 8mEq/5mL
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Bipolar disorder, manic depression
SIDE EFFECTS	light Headed, Shortness of Breathing, Fever
WARNINGS	Breathing problems Heart disease Kidney disease

DRUG NAME	Seroquel
GENERIC NAME	Quetiapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg - 400mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Schizophrenia, Bipolar disorder, anxiety
SIDE EFFECTS	Trouble swallowing, problems with speech, light Headed
WARNINGS	may experience worsening of depression

DRUG NAME	Topamax
GENERIC NAME	Topiramate
DOSAGE RANGE	15mg - 25mg Sprinkle cap 25mg - 200mg Tab
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Seizures, migraine, nightmares PTSD, Sleep related eating
SIDE EFFECTS	Skin rash, Vision Problems Confusion, dehydration
WARNINGS	Vision problems, Birth defects, Body Temp, metabolic acidosis.

DRUG NAME	Klonopin	
GENERIC NAME	Clonazepam	
DOSAGE RANGE	.5mg - 2mg	
HOW TO TAKE	oral	
USES	Panic disorder, anxiety, restless leg syndrome, Confusional	
SIDE EFFECTS	Seizures, drowsiness, weak/shallow breathing, unusual mood ^{changes}	
WARNINGS	narrow-angle glaucoma, severe liver disease,	

DRUG NAME	Triple ptal	
GENERIC NAME	Oxcarbazepine	
DOSAGE RANGE	150mg - 300mg - 600mg Tab	300mg per 5mL SUSP
HOW TO TAKE	Oral	
USES	Trigeminal neuralgia, Bipolar disorder	
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, drowsiness, Balance/coordination problems	
WARNINGS	Skin rash, fever, swollen glands, flu like symptoms	

DRUG NAME	Miralax	
GENERIC NAME	polyethylene glycol 3350	
DOSAGE RANGE	<17yo, >20 kg .2-.8g/kg/dose <17yo, >720 kg 1 capfull	
HOW TO TAKE	Oral	
USES	relieving constipation	
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, cramping, abdominal pain, diarrhea, urticaria	
WARNINGS	electrolyte electrolyte disorder, laxative dependant	

DRUG NAME	Prozac	
GENERIC NAME	Fluoxetine	
DOSAGE RANGE	10mg - 40mg Cap	
HOW TO TAKE	Oral	
USES	major depressive disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder	
SIDE EFFECTS	Blurred vision, fast/pounding heartbeats, low sodium levels	
WARNINGS	may not use with Pimozide or thioridazine	

DRUG NAME	Flonase	
GENERIC NAME	Fluticasone propionate nasal	
DOSAGE RANGE	4-11 1 actuation each nostril	12yo and older 1-2 actuation
HOW TO TAKE	nasal spray ^{each nostril}	
USES	nasal polyp Tx	
SIDE EFFECTS	Headaches, URI sx, epistaxis, nasal burning	
WARNINGS	hypersensitivity rxn, anaphylaxis, glaucoma, cataracts
