DRUG NAME	Miralax
GENERIC NAME	Polyethylene Glycol 3350
DOSAGE RANGE	0.2g - 15g
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Constipation
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, crampy, diarrhea
WARNINGS	electrolyte disorders, laxative dependence

DRUG NAME	Toprol Tenormin
GENERIC NAME	Atenolol
DOSAGE RANGE	20mg - 100mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Hth, angina, migraine headaches, prophylaxis
SIDE EFFECTS	Fatigue, dizziness, leg pain, nausea
WARNINGS	Avoid abrupt cessation

DRUG NAME	Motrin
GENERIC NAME	Ibuprofen
DOSAGE RANGE	one to two tabs by mouth every 4 to 6 hours
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	To reduce pain/inflammation and fever
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, abdominal pain, headache
WARNINGS	GI bleeding, stroke, HTN, CHF, anaphylaxis

DRUG NAME	Flovent
GENERIC NAME	Fluticasone propionate
DOSAGE RANGE	2 actuations in each nostril
HOW TO TAKE	take inhaled
USES	for relieving allergic rhinitis symptoms
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, nasal irritation, vomiting, cough
WARNINGS	anaphylaxis, cataracts, adrenal suppression

DRUG NAME	Depakote
GENERIC NAME	Divalproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	125mg - 500mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	partial seizures, bipolar disorder
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, vomiting, tremors, insomnia
WARNINGS	HEPATOXICITY, Fetal risk, pancreatitis

DRUG NAME	Abilify
GENERIC NAME	Arripiprazole
DOSAGE RANGE	2mg - 30mg
HOW TO TAKE	by injection or mouth
USES	mood stabilizer
SIDE EFFECTS	hypersensitivity, seizures, aspiration
WARNINGS	Dementia Related Psychosis, suicidality

DRUG NAME	Invega
GENERIC NAME	Paliperidone
DOSAGE RANGE	1.5mg - 9mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective disorder
SIDE EFFECTS	excessive anxiety, nausea, weight gain
WARNINGS	Dementia Related Psychosis

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	Atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10mg - 80mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	hypercholesterolemia, mixed dyslipidemia
SIDE EFFECTS	URI, headache, nausea, diarrhea
WARNINGS	myopathy, pancreatitis, tendon rupture

DRUG NAME	Levothyroxine
GENERIC NAME	Levothyroxine
DOSAGE RANGE	13mcg - 300mcg
HOW TO TAKE	injection or by mouth
USES	hypothyroidism, TSH suppression, myxedema coma
SIDE EFFECTS	palpitations, nervousness, tremor, appetite increase
WARNINGS	not for obesity or weight loss

DRUG NAME	Topmax
GENERIC NAME	Topiramate
DOSAGE RANGE	15mg - 200mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	sleep related, migraine headaches, partial seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, weight loss, fertility URI
WARNINGS	anemia, hyperthermia, suicidality
