GENERIC NAME	Aripiprazole
DOSAGE RANGE	2mg - 5mg - 10mg - 15mg - 20mg - 30mg
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	Schizophrenia, Bipolar disorder, Major depressive
SIDE EFFECTS	Severe agitation, twitching or uncontrollable movements
WARNINGS	Dementia - Relates psychosis, suicidality

DRUG NAME	Lorazepam
GENERIC NAME	Lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	10mg tab ODT: 10mg; Sol 1mg
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	Allergy
SIDE EFFECTS	fast uneven heart beat, severe headache
WARNINGS	Do not give to children under 2

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	Atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	Tab 10mg, 20mg, 40mg, 80mg
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	Hypertension, cholesterol, mixed dyslipidemia
SIDE EFFECTS	muscle weakness, trouble breathing
WARNINGS	Do not use if pregnant or breastfeeding

DRUG NAME	Novolog
GENERIC NAME	Insulin aspart
DOSAGE RANGE	Ins 100 units
HOW TO TAKE	Injection
USES	Diabetes
SIDE EFFECTS	heart problem, low potassium, low blood sugar
WARNINGS	Caution in patient 65 or older

DRUG NAME	Topamax
GENERIC NAME	Topiramate
DOSAGE RANGE	Sprinkle cap 15mg, 25mg tab 25mg, 50mg, 100mg
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	Partial seizures, seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	Skin rash, vision problem, confusion, dehydration
WARNINGS	Birth control to be less effective

DRUG NAME	Colace
GENERIC NAME	docusate Sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	2-11 yo 50-150 mg 12 yo and older 50-300mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Stool softener
SIDE EFFECTS	rectal Bleeding or irritation
WARNINGS	N/A

DRUG NAME	Lisinopril
GENERIC NAME	Lisinopril
DOSAGE RANGE	Tab 2.5mg, 5mg, 10mg, 20mg, 30mg, 40mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	heart failure
SIDE EFFECTS	a light head feeling, fever
WARNINGS	Fetal Toxicity

DRUG NAME	flexeril
GENERIC NAME	Cyclobenzaprine
DOSAGE RANGE	5mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	muscle pain
SIDE EFFECTS	Dry mouth, headache, blurred vision, drowsiness
WARNINGS	Not approved for use by anyone than 15 years old

DRUG NAME	Klonopin
GENERIC NAME	Clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	Tab 0.5mg, 1mg, 2mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Seizure disorder, panic disorder, anxiety, restless leg syndrome
SIDE EFFECTS	New or worsening seizures
WARNINGS	Risk from concomitant op ioid use, Addiction, Abuse, misuse

DRUG NAME	Synthroid
GENERIC NAME	Levothyroxine
DOSAGE RANGE	Tab 25mg, 50mg, 75mg, 88mg, 100mg, 112mg, 125mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Hypothyroidism, TSH suppression
SIDE EFFECTS	fast or irregular heart beat, chest pain, Shortness of breath
WARNINGS	Not for obesity or weight loss
