GENERIC NAME	Insulin glargine
DOSAGE RANGE	100 units per ml
HOW TO TAKE	Injection
USES	diabetes mellitus, Type 1 & 2
SIDE EFFECTS	URI; rash, headache, edema; weight gain
WARNINGS	hypoglycemia; if hypokalemia, if visual impairment

DRUG NAME	Keppra
GENERIC NAME	levetiracetam
DOSAGE RANGE	250 mg; 500 mg, 750 mg, 1000 mg
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth, Renal
USES	Partial, Seizures, Juvenile Myoclonic epilepsy
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, Fatigue, Vomiting, anxiety, anorexia
WARNINGS	if pregnant, avoid abrupt withdrawal, if CrCl < 80

DRUG NAME	Colace
GENERIC NAME	docusate Sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	50-300 mg/day
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth, Renal
USES	Stool Softening
SIDE EFFECTS	diarrhea, abdominal cramps, rash, throat irritation
WARNINGS	Fecal impaction, appendicitis, GI obstruction

GENERIC NAME	metoprolol Succinate
DOSAGE RANGE	25 mg, 50 mg, 100 mg, 200 mg,
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth, Renal
USES	HTN, angina, heart failure; Ang pain , migraine
SIDE EFFECTS	Fatigue, dizziness, rash, nightmares
WARNINGS	Black Box Warnings

DRUG NAME	Norco
GENERIC NAME	hydrocodone
DOSAGE RANGE	5 mg/325 mg, 7.5 mg/325 mg, 10 mg/325 mg
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth, Renal
USES	Pain
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, sedation, nausea, constipation
WARNINGS	Black Box Warning

DRUG NAME	Ativan
GENERIC NAME	lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5 mg - 4 mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral, IV, IM, by mouth
USES	Anxiety, Insomnia, Status epilepticus, Nausea
SIDE EFFECTS	Sedation, asthenia, Fatigue, urinary retention
WARNINGS	Black box Warning

DRUG NAME	Klonopin
GENERIC NAME	Clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5 mg - 2 mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth, oral
USES	Restless legs syndrome, Confusional arousals
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, fatigue, confusion, irritability
WARNINGS	Black Box Warning

DRUG NAME	Atrovent
GENERIC NAME	Ipratropium bromide
DOSAGE RANGE	17 mcg
HOW TO TAKE	Inhale, oral
USES	asthma exacerbation
SIDE EFFECTS	Nausea, bronchitis, back pain, UTI
WARNINGS	hypersens, glaucoma, prostatic, bladder neck

DRUG NAME	Flovent
GENERIC NAME	Fluticasone propionate
DOSAGE RANGE	44 mcg, 110 mcg, 220 mcg
HOW TO TAKE	Inhale
USES	asthma, maintenance tx
SIDE EFFECTS	hypersens , headache, dysphonia, cough, nausea
WARNINGS	hypersens, TB infections, measles, Ocular, cataracts

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10 mg, 20 mg, 30 mg, 40 mg, 60 mg, 80 mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth, oral
USES	hypercholesterolemia, mixed dyslipidemia
SIDE EFFECTS	myopathy, hypersens, unexplained, active hepatitis
WARNINGS	URI, headache, UTI, nausea, myalgia
