DRUG NAME	Novolog
GENERIC NAME	Insulin aspart
DOSAGE RANGE	Inject. Pen 100 Units per mL ; Vial 100 units per vial
HOW TO TAKE	.5-1 unit/kg (basal prandial) give 5-10 minutes before meals
USES	Diabetes
SIDE EFFECTS	hypoglycemia, injection site rx, rash, URI, weight gain
WARNINGS	Extreme hypoglycemia, hypokalemia, hypersensitivity rx, Anaphylaxis

DRUG NAME	Synthroid
GENERIC NAME	levothyroxine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mcg Tab to 300 mcg Tab
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth on Empty stomach
USES	Thyroid
SIDE EFFECTS	palpitations, increased appetite, tachycardia, nervousness
WARNINGS	hypersensitivity rx, arrhythmia, CHT, angina, seizures

DRUG NAME	Glucophage
GENERIC NAME	Metformin
DOSAGE RANGE	500mg Tab to 1000mg Tab Max dose of 2550/daily
HOW TO TAKE	By Mouth with meals
USES	Diabetes, Polycystic ovary Syndrome and renal mellitus
SIDE EFFECTS	diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, flatulence, abdominal pain
WARNINGS	lactic acidosis, megaloblastic anemia, hepatotoxicity

DRUG NAME	Lamictal
GENERIC NAME	Lamotrigine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg Tab - 200mg Tab Chewable 2mg - 25mg
HOW TO TAKE	By Mouth or Chew and Swallow
USES	Bipolar, seizures, migraines w/ aura
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, vertigo, headache, ataxia
WARNINGS	rash, Stevens-Johnson syndrome, toxic epidermal necrolysis, suicidal ideation

DRUG NAME	Invega
GENERIC NAME	Paliperidone
DOSAGE RANGE	ER Tabs 1.5mg to 9mg Max 12mg daily
HOW TO TAKE	By Mouth
USES	Schizophrenia / Schizoaffective disorder
SIDE EFFECTS	Parkinsonism, tachycardia, headache, somnolence, URI
WARNINGS	Arrhythmia, AV block, hypotension, orthostatic syncope

GENERIC NAME	Simvastatin	
DOSAGE RANGE	5mg tab to 80 mg Tab (As of 6/8/11 No more than 40mg)	
HOW TO TAKE	By Mouth	
USES	Hypercholesterolemia, Cardiovascular event prevention	
SIDE EFFECTS	URI, headache, abdominal pain, constipation, vertigo	
WARNINGS	myopathy, photosensitivity, tendon rupture, renal failure	

DRUG NAME	Tenormin
GENERIC NAME	atenolol
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg Tab to 100 mg Tab
HOW TO TAKE	By Mouth
USES	Hypertension, Angina, Cardiovascular event prevention
SIDE EFFECTS	bradycardia, hypotension, fatigue, dizziness, leg pain
WARNINGS	CHF, heart blockage, angina if abrupt D/C, Lupus

DRUG NAME	Tylenol
GENERIC NAME	Acetaminophen
DOSAGE RANGE	1-2 tabs/caps PO q4-6h prn; Max 10 tabs or caps
HOW TO TAKE	By Mouth
USES	Pain, fever, headache
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, rash, headache
WARNINGS	hypersensitivity rxn, anaphylaxis, skin rxn renal tubular necrosis

DRUG NAME	Motrin IB
GENERIC NAME	400 mg to 800mg Tablets <del>Ibuprofen</del> Ibuprofen
DOSAGE RANGE	↓ ↓
HOW TO TAKE	By Mouth
USES	Pain, fever, Headache
SIDE EFFECTS	stomach upset, nausea, rash, sleepiness
WARNINGS	Renal failure, edema, anaphylaxis

DRUG NAME	Depakote ER
GENERIC NAME	divalproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	<del>250mg</del> 25mg to 3,500 mg
HOW TO TAKE	Orally
USES	Bipolar, Seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	Diarrhea, dizziness, hair loss, drowsiness, ringing in ears
WARNINGS	Not recommended during pregnancy, can cause liver or kidney problems
