DRUG NAME	Clozari
GENERIC NAME	Clozapine
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB: 12.5mg, 25mg, 50mg, 100mg, 200mg; ODT: 12.5mg, 25mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	treats certain mental/mood disorders (schizophrenia)
SIDE EFFECTS	drooping, drowsiness, headache, lightheadedness
WARNINGS	may cause a condition that affects the heart rhythm

DRUG NAME	Neurontin
GENERIC NAME	Gabapentin
DOSAGE RANGE	CAP: 100mg, 300mg, 400mg; TAB: 600mg, 800mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	prevents and controls seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, dizziness, loss of coordination, tiredness
WARNINGS	may make you dizzy or drowsy

DRUG NAME	Ativan
GENERIC NAME	Lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB: 0.5mg, 1mg, 2mg; INT: 2mg per mL, 4mg per mL
HOW TO TAKE	PO or IV route
USES	treats anxiety
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, dizziness, nausea, blurred vision
WARNINGS	blurs vision

DRUG NAME	Depakote
GENERIC NAME	Divalproex
DOSAGE RANGE	DR TAB: 125mg, 250mg, 500mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	treats seizure disorders, certain psychiatric conditions
SIDE EFFECTS	diarrhea, dizziness, hair loss, blurred/double vision
WARNINGS	may cause dizziness, drowsiness, or blur vision

DRUG NAME	Topamax
GENERIC NAME	Topiramate
DOSAGE RANGE	Sprinkle CAP: 15mg, 25mg; TAB: 25mg, 50mg, 100mg, 200mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	prevent and control seizures (epilepsy)
SIDE EFFECTS	tiredness, drowsiness, loss of coordination
WARNINGS	may impair judgement

DRUG NAME	Zuprexa
GENERIC NAME	Olanzapine
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB: 2.5mg, 5mg, 7.5mg, 10mg, 15mg, 20mg; Inj: 5mg per mL
HOW TO TAKE	PO or Inj
USES	treats schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, and helps treat depression
SIDE EFFECTS	upset stomach, dry mouth, constipation, weight gain
WARNINGS	may cause significant weight gain and higher cholesterol

DRUG NAME	Claritin
GENERIC NAME	Loratadine
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB: 10mg; ODT: 10mg; SOL: 1mg per mL
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	treats itching, runny nose, watery eyes, and sneezing
SIDE EFFECTS	fatigue, headache, diarrhea, drowsiness
WARNINGS	may make you dizzy

DRUG NAME	Halodol - Haloperidol
GENERIC NAME	Haloperidol - Clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB: 0.5mg, 1mg, 2mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	prevents and control seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, dizziness, tiredness, loss of coordination
WARNINGS	may cause new or worsening seizures

DRUG NAME	Lithium
GENERIC NAME	Lithium Carbonate
DOSAGE RANGE	CAP: 150mg, 300mg, 600mg; TAB: 300mg; ER TAB: 300mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	Bipolar disorder
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, diarrhea, dizziness, change in heart rhythm
WARNINGS	may cause dehydration, fever, sweating, diarrhea

DRUG NAME	Dilantin
GENERIC NAME	Phenytoin Sodium Extended
DOSAGE RANGE	ER CAP: 30mg, 100mg; Chewable: 50mg; Susp: 125mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	prevents and controls seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, nausea, vomiting, constipation, dizziness
WARNINGS	may make you dizzy or drowsy
