

DRUG NAME	Klonopin
GENERIC NAME	Clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB 0.5mg 1mg 2mg
HOW TO TAKE	Swallow the regular tablet whole, with full glass of water.
USES	Mental Illness Anxiety Disorders
SIDE EFFECTS	Hives, difficulty breathing, swelling at the face, lips, tongue
WARNINGS	Do not stop using clonazepam suddenly may cause seizures increased

DRUG NAME	Flonase (Adults)
GENERIC NAME	Fluticasone propionate nasal
DOSAGE RANGE	2 actuations in each nostril bid: Max 4 actuations in each nostril.
HOW TO TAKE	50 mcg
USES	Inhalers Allergy / Asthma
SIDE EFFECTS	Headache, nasal burning, nausea, vomiting, cough
WARNINGS	Do not take if allergic

DRUG NAME	Novolog
GENERIC NAME	Insulin Aspart
DOSAGE RANGE	No dosage is define.
HOW TO TAKE	0.5-1 units/kg/day give 5-10 min before meals, when sugar is high or low
USES	Diabetes Endocrine + Metabolic
SIDE EFFECTS	rash, pruritus, weight gain, headache, influenza
WARNINGS	Do not injected medicine into skin that is damage

DRUG NAME	Keppra
GENERIC NAME	levetiracetam
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB: 250mg, 500mg, 750mg, 1000mg
HOW TO TAKE	(Oral) taking by mouth at the same time each day.
USES	Seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	fever, sore throat, burning in your eyes, skin pain, rash
WARNINGS	Do not crush, chew or break the tablet. Take it whole with a sip of water.

DRUG NAME	Zocor
GENERIC NAME	Simvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB 5mg, 10mg, 20mg, 40mg, 80mg
HOW TO TAKE	(Oral) suspension (liquid) on an empty stomach.
USES	Hyperlipidemia Statins
SIDE EFFECTS	Difficult breathing Swelling @ the face, lips, tongue, or throat.
WARNINGS	Should not be taking if you are pregnant or allergic

DRUG NAME	Miralax (Adults)
GENERIC NAME	polyethylene glycol 3350
DOSAGE RANGE	oral powder (dissolve - 4-8oz of liquid)
HOW TO TAKE	let
USES	Gastrointestinal Disorder Constipation
SIDE EFFECTS	Cramping, diarrhea, urticaria, nausea
WARNINGS	Caution in elderly pts or if renal impairments

DRUG NAME	Lisinopril
GENERIC NAME	Lisinopril (Generic)
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB: 2.5mg, 5mg, 10mg, 20mg, 30mg, 40mg
HOW TO TAKE	use the dosing syringe provide or dose measuring
USES	Blood pressure Meds
SIDE EFFECTS	light-headed, fever, sore throat, kidney problems.
WARNINGS	Do not use if pregnant, or if allergic.

DRUG NAME	Tylenol with Codeine #4
GENERIC NAME	acetaminophen/codeine
DOSAGE RANGE	oral TAB 300mg/60mg
HOW TO TAKE	take as directed on prescription label and follow directions
USES	Pain & Inflammation
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, dizziness, feeling tired, nausea.
WARNINGS	Taking certain medications together can lead to a fatal overdose.

DRUG NAME	Lantus
GENERIC NAME	Insulin glargine
DOSAGE RANGE	100 units per ml
HOW TO TAKE	is injected under the skin, usually once per day @ same time
USES	Diabetes Endocrine & Metabolic
SIDE EFFECTS	low blood sugar, swelling, weight gain, itching, rash
WARNINGS	you should not use the medicine if you are allergic

DRUG NAME	Seroquel
GENERIC NAME	Quetiapine
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB: 25mg, 50mg, 100mg, 200mg, 300mg, 400mg
HOW TO TAKE	with or without food, Drink plenty of liquids
USES	Bipolar and Schizophrenia Disorder.
SIDE EFFECTS	speech problems, dizziness, stuffy nose, dry mouth
WARNINGS	increase the risk of death in older adults with dementia - related psychosis and is not approved for this use.
