DRUG NAME	Abilify
GENERIC NAME	Aripiprazole
DOSAGE RANGE	29, 30mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, Major depressive order.
SIDE EFFECTS	diabetes, suicidality
WARNINGS	Black Box Dementia, suicidality

DRUG NAME	Ativan
GENERIC NAME	lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5 mg, 4 mg per ML
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Anxiety insomnia, status epilepticus, nausea/vomiting
SIDE EFFECTS	Sedation, dizziness, asthenia
WARNINGS	Black box risks from concomitant opioid use, Addiction, Abuse, Dependence and withdrawal reaction

DRUG NAME	Clozaril
GENERIC NAME	Clozapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25 mg, 100mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Schizophrenia, suicide prevention
SIDE EFFECTS	dyslipidemia, weight gain, drowsiness, constipation
WARNINGS	Severe neutropenia, orthostatic, Bradycardia, seizures, constipation

DRUG NAME	Ativan Klonopin
GENERIC NAME	clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5 mg, 2 mg
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth
USES	anxiety, restless leg syndrome, confusional arousals, sleep terrors
SIDE EFFECTS	Depression, fatigue, confusion, dizziness
WARNINGS	Risks from concomitant opioid use, Addiction Abuse and misuse dependence and withdrawal reactions.

DRUG NAME	lanatus
GENERIC NAME	insulin glargine
DOSAGE RANGE	100 units per ML
HOW TO TAKE	injection
USES	diabetes mellitus type 1, diabetes Mellitus type 2
SIDE EFFECTS	hypoglycemia, injection site rxn, injection site lipodystrophy
WARNINGS	hypersensitivity rxn, Anaphylaxis, hypoglycemia, hypokalemia

DRUG NAME	Glucophage
GENERIC NAME	Metformin
DOSAGE RANGE	500 MG, 1000 MG
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth
USES	Polycystic ovary Syndrome
SIDE EFFECTS	diarrhea, Nausea, Vomiting, Flatulence
WARNINGS	Lactic Acidosis

DRUG NAME	HOTZ hydrochlorothiazide
GENERIC NAME	hydrochlorothiazide
DOSAGE RANGE	12.5 MG 50 MG
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth
USES	Peripheral edema,
SIDE EFFECTS	hypokalemia, hypochloremia, hyponatremia
WARNINGS	electrolyte imbalance, hypokalemia severe

DRUG NAME	Keppra
GENERIC NAME	levetiracetam
DOSAGE RANGE	250 MG 1000 MG 100 MG PER ML
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth, IV
USES	Juvenile Myoclonic Epilepsy, primary generalized tonic
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, BP incr. cpts < 4%, somnolence, asthenia
WARNINGS	Depression, hostility, aggressive behavior, psychosis

DRUG NAME	Neurontin
GENERIC NAME	gabapentin
DOSAGE RANGE	100 MG 50 MG PER ML
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth three times daily (tid)
USES	Partial seizures, Post-herpetic neuralgia, neuropathic pain, fibromyalgia, ^{alcohol dependence}
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, somnolence, ataxia, fatigue, fever
WARNINGS	depression, suicidality, erythema multiforme

DRUG NAME	Seroquel
GENERIC NAME	quetiapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25 MG 400 MG
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth bid
USES	bipolar disorder manic, bipolar disorder, acute depressive, ^{generalized anxiety disorder}
SIDE EFFECTS	Somnolence, xerostomia, dizziness, hypotension, orthostatic ^{dizziness}
WARNINGS	Suicidality, depression exacerbation, extrapyramidal sx, hypothermia
