GENERIC NAME	clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	.5mg - 2.0mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Panic disorder, anxiety, restless leg syndrome
SIDE EFFECTS	Drowsiness, saliva production
WARNINGS	eye problems, Do not drive

DRUG NAME	Lithium
GENERIC NAME	Escalith
DOSAGE RANGE	150mg - 450mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	bipolar disorder, acute/manic/mixed
SIDE EFFECTS	tremor, polyuria, polydipsia
WARNINGS	coma, seizures

DRUG NAME	Risperdal
GENERIC NAME	risperidone
DOSAGE RANGE	.25 - 4mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	bipolar disorder, Tourette syndrome
SIDE EFFECTS	Somnolence, Fatigue
WARNINGS	Syncope

DRUG NAME	Seroquel
GENERIC NAME	quetiapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg - 400mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	schizophrenia, bipolar, anxiety
SIDE EFFECTS	Somnolence, xerostomia, dizziness
WARNINGS	dystonia, neuroleptic malignant syndrome

DRUG NAME	Zyprexa
GENERIC NAME	olanzapine
DOSAGE RANGE	2.5mg - 20mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	bipolar disorder, agitation
SIDE EFFECTS	weight gain, somnolence, hyperprolactinemia
WARNINGS	Dementia related psychosis

DRUG NAME	Ativan
GENERIC NAME	lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	.5mg - 4mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral - pill or liquid
USES	Anxiety, insomnia, epileptics, Alcohol withdrawal ect...
SIDE EFFECTS	Respiratory depression, apnea, respiratory failure ect...
WARNINGS	Severe drowsiness, unusual changes in mood, sudden restlessness

DRUG NAME	Clozaril
GENERIC NAME	clozapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg - 100mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral - pill or liquid w/no food
USES	Schizophrenia, renal dosing, hepatic dosing,
SIDE EFFECTS	agranulocytosis, neutropenia, seizures
WARNINGS	dyslipidemia, hyperglycemia

DRUG NAME	Depakote
GENERIC NAME	divalproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	125mg - 500mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Seizures, bipolar
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, nausea, vomiting, asthenia
WARNINGS	hepatotoxicity, pancreatitis

DRUG NAME	Haldol
GENERIC NAME	haloperidol
DOSAGE RANGE	5mg 5mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	mood disorders
SIDE EFFECTS	Dizziness, lightheadedness, headache
WARNINGS	Fainting

DRUG NAME	Invega
GENERIC NAME	paliperidone
DOSAGE RANGE	1.5 - 9 mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Schizophrenia
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, weight gain
WARNINGS	Muscle spasms
