GENERIC NAME	Lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	<del>0.5</del> 0.5 mg - 4 mg
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	Anxiety, insomnia (Sleep difficulty)
SIDE EFFECTS	Abuse, Seizures, dependency
WARNINGS	Avoid Alcohol use, Caution if pregnant.

DRUG NAME	Klonopin
GENERIC NAME	Clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5 mg - 20 mg
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	panic attack, <del>head</del> control seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	Abuse, withdrawal, drowsiness
WARNINGS	Depression, renal impairment

DRUG NAME	Motrin IB
GENERIC NAME	ibuprofen
DOSAGE RANGE	1-2 tabs - 6 tabs
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	reducing pain & inflammation
SIDE EFFECTS	Stroke, Ulcer
WARNINGS	Caution if pregnant

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	Atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10-20 mg - 80 mg/day
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	Lower blood levels of "bad" cholesterol
SIDE EFFECTS	<del>muscle pain</del> nausea, insomnia
WARNINGS	ana phylaxis, leukemia

DRUG NAME	Norco
GENERIC NAME	<del>hydrocodone</del> Hydrocodone
DOSAGE RANGE	2.5 mg - 10 mg
HOW TO TAKE	Oral
USES	pain reliever
SIDE EFFECTS	Abuse to drug, depression
WARNINGS	if used with alcohol

DRUG NAME	Zantac
GENERIC NAME	famotidine
DOSAGE RANGE	1 tab - 2 tabs
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	preventing and relieving heartburn.
SIDE EFFECTS	gastric alkalinizer
WARNINGS	renal impairment

DRUG NAME	Seroquel
GENERIC NAME	quetiapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25 mg - 400mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	to treat: Schizophrenia, bipolar
SIDE EFFECTS	depression, Stroke
WARNINGS	Caution if: Suicide risk, leukemia

DRUG NAME	Proventil
GENERIC NAME	albuterol
DOSAGE RANGE	1 - 2 puffs
HOW TO TAKE	Inhaled
USES	Asthma
SIDE EFFECTS	throat reactions, dizziness
WARNINGS	Caution if: Seizures

DRUG NAME	Dilantin
GENERIC NAME	phenytoin
DOSAGE RANGE	30 mg - 125mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	Cardiac arrest, hypotension
WARNINGS	Caution if: Alcohol abuse

DRUG NAME	Toprol
GENERIC NAME	metoprolol Succinate
DOSAGE RANGE	25 mg - 200 mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	treat chest pain, heart failure.
SIDE EFFECTS	heart block, gangrene
WARNINGS	Severe heart failure
