DRUG NAME	Ativan
GENERIC NAME	lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	2-6mg
HOW TO TAKE	daily at routine times
USES	anxiety, stress, Alcohol withdraws
SIDE EFFECTS	Insomnia Sedation
WARNINGS	hepatic failure renal failure Addiction depression

DRUG NAME	Clozaril
GENERIC NAME	FazaClo, Versacloz, Clozagine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg - 100mg
HOW TO TAKE	1-2 times per day
USES	Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective disorders
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, headache, tremor, drowsiness
WARNINGS	dry mouth, restlessness, headache

DRUG NAME	Depakote
GENERIC NAME	Delakote ER, Depakote sprinkles, Divalproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	125mg 250mg 500mg
HOW TO TAKE	Two - three times a day
USES	Complex partial seizures, complex absence seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, nausea, abdominal pain, diarrhea
WARNINGS	Dizziness, hair loss, drowsiness

DRUG NAME	Haldol
GENERIC NAME	haloperidol
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5mg - 20mg
HOW TO TAKE	1-2 times a day
USES	mental / mood disorders
SIDE EFFECTS	Dizziness, lightheadedness, anxiety
WARNINGS	Dizziness risk of falling, anxiety, headache

DRUG NAME	Invega
GENERIC NAME	Paliperidone
DOSAGE RANGE	1.5mg - 9mg
HOW TO TAKE	once daily
USES	Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective disorders
SIDE EFFECTS	abnormal muscle movements, shuffling, involuntary movements
WARNINGS	Dementia-related psychosis

DRUG NAME	Klonopin
GENERIC NAME	Klonopin waters, Clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5mg - 2mg
HOW TO TAKE	Once a day or PRN
USES	Prevent and control seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	Drowsiness, dizziness, increased saliva
WARNINGS	Confusion, unusual changes in mood, aggression

DRUG NAME	Lithium
GENERIC NAME	Eskalith, Lithobid
DOSAGE RANGE	150mg - 600mg
HOW TO TAKE	1-3 times per day
USES	Treat and prevent episodes of mania
SIDE EFFECTS	Headache, dry mouth, hand tremors, Diarrhea
WARNINGS	

DRUG NAME	Risperdal
GENERIC NAME	Percecis, risperidone, Risperdal m-tab, risperdal consta
DOSAGE RANGE	0.25mg - 4mg
HOW TO TAKE	1-2 times a day
USES	Treat certain mental/mood disorders
SIDE EFFECTS	Drowsiness, drooling, weight gain, tiredness
WARNINGS	Not approved in elderly patients

DRUG NAME	Seroquel
GENERIC NAME	Seroquel XR, quetiapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg - 400mg
HOW TO TAKE	1-3 times a day
USES	Schizophrenia
SIDE EFFECTS	dry mouth, indigestion, dizziness
WARNINGS	Constipation, drowsiness, weight gain

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10mg - 80mg
HOW TO TAKE	once a day
USES	help lower bad cholesterol
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, heartburn, nausea, fatigue
WARNINGS	Diarrhea, muscle or joint pain, upset stomach
