DRUG NAME	ABILIFY
GENERIC NAME	Aripiprazole
DOSAGE RANGE	2mg tabs - 30mg tabs
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth - daily
USES	Schizophrenia, bipolar, major depressive disorder, renal & hepatic
SIDE EFFECTS	Dementia - Related Psychosis, Suicidality
WARNINGS	headaches, weight gain, anxiety, insomnia, nausea

DRUG NAME	ATIVAN
GENERIC NAME	lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5 mg tab - 4mg per ML
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth - as needed - daily
USES	Anxiety, insomnia, status epilepticus, nausea/vomiting - chem
SIDE EFFECTS	Sedation, dizziness, asthenia, ataxia, hypotension ^{react}
WARNINGS	Addiction, Abuse, Misuse, Dependence & Withdrawal Reactions

DRUG NAME	CLOZARIL
GENERIC NAME	Clozapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25 mg tab - 100 mg tab
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth - daily
USES	Schizophrenia, Suicide Prevention, renal & hepatic dosing
SIDE EFFECTS	hyperglycemia, weight gain, drowsiness, dizziness
WARNINGS	Severe Neutropenia, Orthostatic Hypotension, Bradycardia

DRUG NAME	DEPAKOTE
GENERIC NAME	divalproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	125 mg, 250 mg, 500 mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth - daily
USES	Partial Seizures, Absence Seizures, Bipolar, Migranes
SIDE EFFECTS	Headache, Nausea, Vomiting, Asthenia, Somnolence
WARNINGS	Hepatotoxicity, Fetal Risk, Pancreatitis

DRUG NAME	HALDOL info on Epocrates MIRALAX
GENERIC NAME	haloperidol - Polyethylene glycol 3350
DOSAGE RANGE	20 kg
HOW TO TAKE	oral powder
USES	Osmotic laxative for relieving constipation
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, abdominal distension, cramping
WARNINGS	on Epocrates

DRUG NAME	FLONASE FLONASE
GENERIC NAME	fluticasone propionate nasal
DOSAGE RANGE	1-2 actuations in each nostril bid / daily
HOW TO TAKE	" " " " " " " "
USES	corticosteroid for relieving allergic rhinitis symptoms
SIDE EFFECTS	headaches, epistaxis, nasal burning or irritation
WARNINGS	none

DRUG NAME	LIPITOR
GENERIC NAME	atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10mg tab, 20mg tab, 40mg tab & 80mg tab
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth 4x a day
USES	hypercholesterolemia, mixed dyslipidemia, dysbetalipoproteinemia
SIDE EFFECTS	URI, headache, dyspepsia, myalgia, insomnia, UTI
WARNINGS	Do NOT take if you are pregnant, nursing or have liver disease

DRUG NAME	LANTUS
GENERIC NAME	insulin glargine
DOSAGE RANGE	100 units per ML
HOW TO TAKE	Injection
USES	diabetes type 1 & 2, renal & hepatic dosing
SIDE EFFECTS	hypoglycemia, myalgia, weight gain, headache
WARNINGS	never share an injection pen, even if you changed the needle.

DRUG NAME	DILANTIN
GENERIC NAME	phenytoin
DOSAGE RANGE	30mg ^{cap} , 100mg ^{cap} , CHEWABLE: 50mg / SUSP: 125mg per 5ml
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth or susp
USES	Status epilepticus, seizure disorder, seizure disorder
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, vomiting, ataxia, dizziness, confusion
WARNINGS	Cardiovascular Risk w/ Rapid Infusion, URI

DRUG NAME	TOPROL
GENERIC NAME	topiramate
DOSAGE RANGE	SPRINKLE CAP: 15mg, 25mg TAB: 25mg, 50mg, 100mg, 200mg
HOW TO TAKE	By mouth
USES	Partial Seizures, migraines, sleep related eating disorder
SIDE EFFECTS	metabolic acidosis, paresthesia, URI, dizziness
WARNINGS
