HOW TO TAKE	PO daily
USES	schizophrenia autistic tourette syndrome
SIDE EFFECTS (se)	stroke, seizures
WARNINGS (SD) <i>caution</i>	dehydration, heart failure elderly DTS

GENERIC NAME	quetiapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg 50mg 100mg 200mg 300mg 400mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO daily
USES	Anxiety, bipolar disorder, acute depressive
SIDE EFFECTS	depression exacerbation dystonia, hyperthermia
WARNINGS	hypotension, dysphagia breast CIA Constipation

DRUG NAME	Flonase Allergy relief
GENERIC NAME	Xhance, fluticasone propionate nasal
DOSAGE RANGE	4-11yo 1 actuation in each nostril, Adults - 2 in each ^{50mg} nostril
HOW TO TAKE	Spray in Nostril
USES	Corticosteroid for relieving allergic rhinitis
SIDE EFFECTS	hypersensitivity rxn, glaucoma growth Suppr
WARNINGS	Nasal septal ulcer nasal wound TB infection

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	Atorvastatin, Caduet
DOSAGE RANGE	10, 20, 40, 80 mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO daily
USES	mixed dyslipidemia, Cardiovascular event ^{prevention}
SIDE EFFECTS	headach, nausea, myalgia, Insomnia
WARNINGS	UTI diarrhea, UTI , headach Stroke, hepatic

DRUG NAME	Crestor
GENERIC NAME	rosuvastatin, Ezallor sprinkle Roszet
DOSAGE RANGE	5, 10, 20, 40 mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO daily
USES	mixed dyslipidemia, hypercholesterolemia
SIDE EFFECTS	headach abdominal Pain Asthenia Nausea
WARNINGS	hepatic, hypothyroidism renal Impairment

DRUG NAME	Levetra
GENERIC NAME	Levetiracetam
DOSAGE RANGE	250 500 750 1000mg SOL 100mg Per mL
HOW TO TAKE	PO / IV
USES	Partial seizures; generalized tonic clonic
SIDE EFFECTS	confusion amnesia, vomiting, infection
WARNINGS	psychiatric disorder, avoid abrupt withdrawal

DRUG NAME	Neurontin
GENERIC NAME	Gabapentin
DOSAGE RANGE	Restless legs alcohol dependence, partial seizures
HOW TO TAKE	PO daily
USES	100 300 400 CAP TAB 600mg (C/D)
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness tremor diplopia, headache
WARNINGS	drug abuse hx depression respiratory

DRUG NAME	Prilosec
GENERIC NAME	Omeprazole
DOSAGE RANGE	PR CAP 10 20 40mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO / NG daily 4x 8wk
USES	gastric ulcer, duodenal ulcer
SIDE EFFECTS	headache nausea vomiting fever
WARNINGS	long term use, high dose use

DRUG NAME	Ultram NORCO
GENERIC NAME	hydrocodone/acetaminophen
DOSAGE RANGE	5mg/325mg 7.5/325mg 10mg/325mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO daily
USES	Pain Moderate to severe
SIDE EFFECTS	lightheadness, dizziness, sedation, vomiting, rash
WARNINGS	ICP incr hypotension acute abdomen

DRUG NAME	Tenormin
GENERIC NAME	atenolol
DOSAGE RANGE	TAB 2.5, 50, 100mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO daily
USES	HTN angina migraine headache prophylaxis
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, fatigue lethargy vertigo chills, leg pain
WARNINGS	myasthenia gravis severe anaphylactic rxn
