Normal Temperature Range: 96° - 99° *104 treat temp*
- Weight *If weight under 10lbs put on weight every 2 weeks.*
- Measurement of Girth *on stomach*
- Oxygen Saturation (Only to be completed per physician or nurse order) *Temps and O<sub>2</sub> twice a day IF exposed to Covid.*
- Wong Baker Chart & FLACC Scale *1-10 pain scale*
- Insulin Administration *put in the fridge until use Good only 28 days after use put in temp*
- SubQ Injections *IF have to inject you have put date on it when open*
- Accu-Chek (Glucometer Testing) *to call 911*
- Glucometer Use and Cleaning *70 and lower. If low call nurse and they will tell you to give resident the sugar kit*
- Transfers (on an as-needed basis):
  - Hoyer Lift
  - Gait Belt
  - Wheelchair Transfers *when pump up goes to 200*
- Feeding Tube
- Foley Catheter Care *IF person have higher blood pressure pump to 200*
- Colostomy *first heart beat is top number last heart beat is your bottom number*

Date all insulin after opening

when giving meds pop from highest to lowest.
