GENERIC NAME	not Available
DOSAGE RANGE	100 (iu) 1 ml.
HOW TO TAKE	Injection
USES	Type 2 diabetes.
SIDE EFFECTS	Hypoglycemia, Hypersensitivity and allergic Reactions.
WARNINGS	hypoglycemia

DRUG NAME	Toprol
GENERIC NAME	metoprolol Succinate
DOSAGE RANGE	ER tab 25 mg 50mg 100mg 200mg.
HOW TO TAKE	oral.
USES	HTN, Angina, heart failure, migraine headache
SIDE EFFECTS	CHF, fatigue, dizziness, rash, depression
WARNINGS	<del>no</del> <del>no</del> Severe Angina sinus bradycardia

DRUG NAME	<del>Flexin</del> Motrin
GENERIC NAME	Ibuprofen
DOSAGE RANGE	1-2 tabs q 4-6 hr up to max 6 tabs.
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	pain / inflammation, fever.
SIDE EFFECTS	GI bleeding, dizziness, rash, nausea.
WARNINGS	Swelling, Vomiting, weight gain.

DRUG NAME	Norco
GENERIC NAME	hydrocodone / acetaminophen
DOSAGE RANGE	5mg / 325mg. 7.5mg / 325mg 10mg / 325mg.
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	relieve moderate to severe pain.
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, rash, Constipation, Sedation, Constipation.
WARNINGS	Addiction, breathing problems.

DRUG NAME	<del>Atazan</del> Protonix
GENERIC NAME	Pantoprazole.
DOSAGE RANGE	20mg 40mg.
HOW TO TAKE	oral.
USES	pain GERD.
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting.
WARNINGS	Severe Stomach pain, diarrhea, Swelling.

DRUG NAME	Depakote
GENERIC NAME	div Valproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	125mg 250mg 500mg.
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Seizures, bipolar, migraine.
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, diarrhea, vomiting, nausea, tremor.
WARNINGS	Organic brain dz, bleeding risk, head injury.

DRUG NAME	Flozase
GENERIC NAME	Fluticasone propionate nasal
DOSAGE RANGE	2 puffs each nostril bid max - 4 puffs in each nostril daily
HOW TO TAKE	OTC
USES	Corticosteroid for relieving Allergic Rhinitis.
SIDE EFFECTS	hypersensitivity rxn, headache, cough, dizziness
WARNINGS	TB infection, glaucoma, Measles, nasal septal ulcer.

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	Atorvastatin.
DOSAGE RANGE	10mg 20mg 40mg 80mg.
HOW TO TAKE	oral.
USES	hypercholesterolemia, mixed dyslipidemia
SIDE EFFECTS	UTI, headache, LTI, myalgia, nausea.
WARNINGS	Alcohol Abuse, Myopathy, hypothyroidism, diabetes

DRUG NAME	Neurontin
GENERIC NAME	gabapentin.
DOSAGE RANGE	100mg 300mg 400mg 600mg 800mg 500- mg prn
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	partial Seizures, Neuropathic pain, fibromyalgia
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, ataxia, fatigue, nausea, vomiting.
WARNINGS	Depression, suicidality, dizziness, fatigue.

DRUG NAME	Colace
GENERIC NAME	docusate sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	50-150 mg/day. PO divided qd-bid prn.
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	oral stool softening
SIDE EFFECTS	diarrhea, Abd. Cramps, Rash, bitter taste
WARNINGS	fecal impaction, Acute Abdomen GI obstruction
