GENERIC NAME	Clozapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg - 50mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	Schizophrenia
SIDE EFFECTS	↑BP, dizziness, headache, nausea, dry mouth, Fever
WARNINGS	Can cause fainting

DRUG NAME	Zyprexa
GENERIC NAME	Olanzapine
DOSAGE RANGE	10-15mg per day
HOW TO TAKE	Im
USES	Antipsychotic
SIDE EFFECTS	Drowsiness, dizziness, Constipation
WARNINGS	May interact w/ BP meds

DRUG NAME	Flonase
GENERIC NAME	Fluticasone
DOSAGE RANGE	2 sprays (50mcg)
HOW TO TAKE	IN
USES	Treats sneezing, Itchy & runny nose
SIDE EFFECTS	Tiredness, headache
WARNINGS	eye pain, nose bleeds, white patches on nose and throat mouth

DRUG NAME	Zocor
GENERIC NAME	Simvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10-20mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	lower cholesterol
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, nausea, stomach pain, constipation
WARNINGS	loss of appetite, tiredness, itching, dark urine, Jaundice

DRUG NAME	Glucophage
GENERIC NAME	Metformin
DOSAGE RANGE	850-1000mg
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	Diabetes
SIDE EFFECTS	Nausea, vomiting, headache
WARNINGS	lactic acidosis

DRUG NAME	Dilantin
GENERIC NAME	Phenytoin
DOSAGE RANGE	100mg PO TID
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	Seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	uneven heartbeats, chest pain, Fever, easy Bruising
WARNINGS	diabetes, anemia, low platelets, low WBC

DRUG NAME	Miralax
GENERIC NAME	polyethylenglycol 3350
DOSAGE RANGE	17g
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	laxative (poop)
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, belly ache, bloating, gas, sluggishness
WARNINGS	low Na, low K, low calcium

DRUG NAME	Zantac
GENERIC NAME	ranitidine
DOSAGE RANGE	150 TID
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	stomach poop
SIDE EFFECTS	poop too much
WARNINGS	Cancer, pregnancy

DRUG NAME	Norco
GENERIC NAME	Acetaminophen & hydrocodone
DOSAGE RANGE	1-2 capsules
HOW TO TAKE	PO
USES	Pain
SIDE EFFECTS	Anxiety, withdrawal
WARNINGS	Alcohol

DRUG NAME	Novolog
GENERIC NAME	insulin
DOSAGE RANGE	.2-.6 kg/unit
HOW TO TAKE	IM
USES	Diabetes
SIDE EFFECTS	Nausea, vomiting
WARNINGS	Hypoglycemia, liver problems
