DRUG NAME	Ativan
GENERIC NAME	Lorazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	1 to 10 mg a day
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Anxiety, insomnia, or sleep difficulty
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, dizziness, lightheadedness, stomach
WARNINGS	upset in creased death and heart related issues.

DRUG NAME	Clonazepam
GENERIC NAME	clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	starting dose is 1.5 mg once daily or twice a day
HOW TO TAKE	orally by tablets or liquid once or twice daily
USES	Schizophrenia and schizoaffective disorders
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, dizziness, lightheadedness, headache
WARNINGS	fatal side effects.

DRUG NAME	Zyprexa
GENERIC NAME	olanzapine
DOSAGE RANGE	5 to 20 mg daily
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	Schizophrenia, bipolar
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, dizziness, lightheadedness, stomach upset
WARNINGS	increased death and heart related issues.

DRUG NAME	lipitor
GENERIC NAME	atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10-80 mg daily
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	helps lower bad cholesterol and facts joint
SIDE EFFECTS	pain, stomach pain, nausea,
WARNINGS	liver problems and muscle problems that can lead to death.

DRUG NAME	Advair Diskus
GENERIC NAME	Wixela, fluticasone/salmeterol
DOSAGE RANGE	1 to 10 mg a day
HOW TO TAKE	1 to 10 mg a day and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
USES	for for asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
SIDE EFFECTS	fever, chills, increased cough
WARNINGS	could increase the risk of life threatening asthma attacks.

DRUG NAME	Narco
GENERIC NAME	hydrocodone
DOSAGE RANGE	5mg-325mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral 12 capsules every 4-6 hrs
USES	for pain
SIDE EFFECTS	nausea, vomiting, dizziness
WARNINGS	can result in addiction abuse and misuse

DRUG NAME	Motrin
GENERIC NAME	ibuprofen
DOSAGE RANGE	200-400mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral one every 4-6 hrs
USES	for pain
SIDE EFFECTS	upset stomach, nausea, vomiting
WARNINGS	may increase risk for heart attack

DRUG NAME	Miralax
GENERIC NAME	polyethylene glycol 3350
DOSAGE RANGE	17 grams
HOW TO TAKE	17g in any 4 to 8 ounces of beverage once daily
USES	to treat bleating gas constipation
SIDE EFFECTS	to treat gas, bloating, nausea
WARNINGS	could lead to liver damages.

DRUG NAME	Neurontin
GENERIC NAME	Gabapentin
DOSAGE RANGE	300-600mg 3x's daily
HOW TO TAKE	oral with or without food
USES	helps with seizures and relieve pain
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness dizziness blurred vision
WARNINGS	Serious breathing difficulties may occur.

DRUG NAME	Zantac
GENERIC NAME	ranitidine
DOSAGE RANGE	15mg-300mg
HOW TO TAKE	injection or orally
USES	prevent and treat reactivation
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, diarrhea, fatigue in sunbath
WARNINGS	Death
