User Security Access Requirements: Available to all staff


Beacon User Role: Available to all staff

How to Register:

Pull up Google Chrome or any other web browser and go to <https://www.epocrates.com/>

You will now be the Epocrates home page.



Click on "Login" in the upper right-hand corner of the page.

GENERIC NAME	divalproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	125mg 250mg 500mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	Mania, Epilepsy, Migraine Prophylaxis
SIDE EFFECTS	headache, nausea, vomiting, asthenia, dizziness, insomnia
WARNINGS	Hepatotoxicity, Teratogenicity, Pancreatitis

DRUG NAME	Lisinopril
GENERIC NAME	lisinopril
DOSAGE RANGE	2.5mg 5mg 10mg 20mg 30mg 40mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	hypertension, acute myocardial infarction, heart failure
SIDE EFFECTS	hypotension, cough,
WARNINGS	do not take when pregnant

DRUG NAME	Dilantin
GENERIC NAME	phenytoin
DOSAGE RANGE	30mg 100mg (capsule) - 50mg (tablet) - 50mg/mL
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth, infusion
USES	seizures, anticonvulsant
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, fatigue, ataxia, irritability, headache, vertigo
WARNINGS	cardiovascular risk associated w/ rapid infusion rates

DRUG NAME	Flonase
GENERIC NAME	fluticasone propionate nasal spray
DOSAGE RANGE	1-2 activations in each nostril
HOW TO TAKE	nasal spray
USES	Relieving allergic rhinitis symptoms
SIDE EFFECTS	nosebleeds, cough, headache, sinus pain, sore throat
WARNINGS	anaphylaxis, glaucoma, cataracts, immunosuppression

DRUG NAME	Ultram
GENERIC NAME	tramadol hcl
DOSAGE RANGE	50mg, 100mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	pain
SIDE EFFECTS	noisy breathing, sighing, shallow breathing, nausea
WARNINGS	addiction, respiratory depression, accidental ingestion
