User Security Access Requirements: Available to all staff



HOW TO TAKE	Tab
USES	Angina, migraine, HTN, heart failure
SIDE EFFECTS	Fatigue, dizziness, rash, depression
WARNINGS	avoid abrupt cessation

GENERIC NAME	hydrocodone / acetaminophen
DOSAGE RANGE	5mg / 325mg 7.5mg / 325mg 10mg / 325mg
HOW TO TAKE	Tab
USES	pain
SIDE EFFECTS	respiratory depression, sleep apnea, seizure, abuse
WARNINGS	med error risk, additive, opioid analgesic

DRUG NAME	Inuaga
GENERIC NAME	paliperidone
DOSAGE RANGE	1.5mg, 3mg, 6mg, 9mg
HOW TO TAKE	er tab
USES	Schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, cataplexy
SIDE EFFECTS	anxiety, nausea, cough, cataplexy
WARNINGS	dementia

DRUG NAME	Klonopin
GENERIC NAME	clonazepam clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	.5, 1mg, 2mg
HOW TO TAKE	Tab
USES	seizure, panic anxiety, sleep terrors
SIDE EFFECTS	drowsiness, dizziness, depression
WARNINGS	addiction, dependency risk from concomitant opioid use

DRUG NAME	Abilify
GENERIC NAME	Aripiprazole
DOSAGE RANGE	2mg, 5mg, 10mg, 15mg, 20mg, 30mg
HOW TO TAKE	Tab
USES	bipolar, depressive disorder, schizophrenia, tourettes
SIDE EFFECTS	weight gain, restlessness, sleepiness
WARNINGS	dementia-related psychosis, suicidality

DRUG NAME	Flonase
GENERIC NAME	Fluticasone propionate nasal
DOSAGE RANGE	2 actuations in each nostril bid, 4 actuations each nostril bid
HOW TO TAKE	nasal spray
USES	allergy relief
SIDE EFFECTS	hypersens, unhealed nasal septal ulcer
WARNINGS	non

DRUG NAME	Lipitor
GENERIC NAME	atorvastatin
DOSAGE RANGE	10mg, 20mg, 40mg, 80mg
HOW TO TAKE	Tab
USES	hypercholesterolemia, mixed dyslipidemia
SIDE EFFECTS	hypersens, myopathy, active hepatic
WARNINGS	non

DRUG NAME	Lantus
GENERIC NAME	insulin glargine
DOSAGE RANGE	100 units per ml pen or vial
HOW TO TAKE	injection
USES	diabetics
SIDE EFFECTS	visual impairment, injection site pain, infections
WARNINGS	non

DRUG NAME	Topamax
GENERIC NAME	topiramate
DOSAGE RANGE	15mg, 25mg, (25mg, 50mg, 100mg, 200mg)
HOW TO TAKE	Sprinkle cap or tab
USES	Seizures, migraines, sleep related eating disorders
SIDE EFFECTS	Suicide thoughts, hypokalemia, depression
WARNINGS	non
