DRUG NAME	Abilify
GENERIC NAME	aripiprazole
DOSAGE RANGE	2mg - 30mg
HOW TO TAKE	orally
USES	Schizophrenia, bipolar I disorder, major depressive
SIDE EFFECTS	Headache, weight gain, anxiety, insomnia, nausea
WARNINGS	Anaphylaxis, dystonia, seizures, aspiration

DRUG NAME	Haldol Clozane
GENERIC NAME	haloperidol clozapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg, 100mg
HOW TO TAKE	oral
USES	sent schizophrenia, suicide prevention
SIDE EFFECTS	dyslipidemia, hyperglycemia, weight gain, drowsiness
WARNINGS	seizures, neutropenia, arrhythmia, stroke

DRUG NAME	Depakote
GENERIC NAME	divalproex sodium
DOSAGE RANGE	125mg, 250mg, 500mg
HOW TO TAKE	orally
USES	partial seizures, absence seizures, bipolar disorder
SIDE EFFECTS	Headache, nausea, vomiting, tremor, alopecia
WARNINGS	Thrombocytopenia, hypothermia, hyponatremia

DRUG NAME	Risperdal
GENERIC NAME	risperidone
DOSAGE RANGE	0.25mg - 1mg
HOW TO TAKE	orally
USES	Schizophrenia, bipolar I disorder, Tourette syndrome
SIDE EFFECTS	increased appetite, fatigue, anxiety, dizziness
WARNINGS	Hypotension, syncope, tardive dyskinesia

DRUG NAME	Invega
GENERIC NAME	paliperidone
DOSAGE RANGE	Extended release 15mg, 3mg, 6mg, 9mg
HOW TO TAKE	orally
USES	Schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder,
SIDE EFFECTS	Tachycardia, headache, weight gain
WARNINGS	Arrhythmia, tardive dyskinesia, hyperglycemia

DRUG NAME	Klonopin
GENERIC NAME	Clonazepam
DOSAGE RANGE	0.5mg - 2mg
HOW TO TAKE	orally
USES	seizure disorder, panic disorder, anxiety
SIDE EFFECTS	Drowsiness, impaired coordination, dizziness
WARNINGS	Respiratory depression, seizures, suicidality

DRUG NAME	Lamictal
GENERIC NAME	lamotrigine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg - 200 mg oral, 2mg - 25mg chewable
HOW TO TAKE	orally - swallow or chewable
USES	Bipolar I disorder, partial seizures, seizures
SIDE EFFECTS	Dizziness, vertigo, headache, rash
WARNINGS	Rash (severe), angioedema, suicidality

DRUG NAME	Trileptal
GENERIC NAME	Oxcarbazepine
DOSAGE RANGE	150 mg - 30 mg
HOW TO TAKE	orally
USES	partial seizures, trigeminal neuralgia, bipolar disorder
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, headache, nausea, vomiting, ataxia
WARNINGS	Hyponatremia, anaphylaxis, angioedema

DRUG NAME	Seroquel
GENERIC NAME	quetiapine
DOSAGE RANGE	25mg - 400mg
HOW TO TAKE	orally
USES	Schizophrenia, bipolar I disorder, anxiety
SIDE EFFECTS	dizziness, BP increase, tremor, tachycardia
WARNINGS	Suicidality, dystonia, tardive dyskinesia

DRUG NAME	Zyprexa
GENERIC NAME	olanzapine
DOSAGE RANGE	2.5mg - 20mg oral 5mg per mL injectable
HOW TO TAKE	orally, injectable
USES	Schizophrenia, bipolar I disorder, agitation
SIDE EFFECTS	Dystonia, tardive dyskinesia, dysphagia
WARNINGS	weight gain, headache, back pain, abdominal pain
