DRUG NAME	Apidra
GENERIC NAME	insulin glulisine
DOSAGE RANGE	IUS 100 units per mL
HOW TO TAKE	Injection
USES	diabetes mellitus,
SIDE EFFECTS	hypoglycemia, seizures, anaphylaxis, myalgia, rash, URT
WARNINGS	look out for adverse and common reactions

DRUG NAME	Ultram
GENERIC NAME	tramadol
DOSAGE RANGE	follow dosage for tramadol
HOW TO TAKE	follow instructions for tramadol
USES	Pain med as needed
SIDE EFFECTS	watch for interactions in meds
WARNINGS	Brand discontinued in US

DRUG NAME	Tenormin
GENERIC NAME	atenolol
DOSAGE RANGE	Tab 25mg, 50mg, 100mg
HOW TO TAKE	by mouth
USES	angina, cardiovascular event prevention, post-MI
SIDE EFFECTS	severe bradycardia, heart block, hypotension, leg pain
WARNINGS	avoid abrupt cessation

DRUG NAME	Novolog
GENERIC NAME	Insulin aspart
DOSAGE RANGE	100 units per mL
HOW TO TAKE	Injection, Flex pen, Relion L100 pen
USES	Diabetes mellitus type 1 and type 2
SIDE EFFECTS	hypokalemia, hypoglycemia, weight gain, headache
WARNINGS	avoid taking certain medications

DRUG NAME	Atrovent HFA
GENERIC NAME	ipratropium bromide inhaled
DOSAGE RANGE	MDI: 17 mcg per actuation
HOW TO TAKE	inhale
USES	copd maintenance, asthma exacerbation, mod-severe
SIDE EFFECTS	hypersensitivity rxn, dyspnea, xerostomia
WARNINGS	watch out for drug interactions
