- Insulin Administration ^{Both workers need to sign verification} weave pin in for 10 seconds.
- SubQ Injections
- Accu-Chek (Glucometer Testing) - Every diabetic person has one
- Glucometer Use and Cleaning ^{clean finger, put strip in glucometer}
- Transfers (on an as-needed basis): - require a doctors order
 - Hoyer Lift
 - Gait Belt - around waist
 - Wheelchair Transfers - brakes locked when getting out of it
- Feeding Tube - have to be setting up at 45 to 90 degrees down nose or
- Foley Catheter Care - clean it twice a day. - point that enters the body down to the bag. - Any time connection is broken clean with new alcohol pad.
- Colostomy - take it off and throw it away and replace it.
