3 Drug name: Proventil HFA

Generic name: albuterol inhaled

Dosage Range: 1-12 puffs (1 actuation = 108 mcg albuterol

sulfate, equivalent to 90 mcg albuterol base)

How to take: (x) Puff inhaled

Uses: Bronchospasm

Side Effects: Throat irritation, cough, bad taste, dizziness, nausea, vomiting, headache

Warnings: Could become hypersensitive to other meds and milk protein.

4 Drug name: Zocor

Generic name: Simvastatin

Dosage Range: 5-80 mg

How to take: By mouth

Uses: Hypercholesterolemia, dyslipidemia, hypertriglyceridemia, dysbetalipoproteinemia  
Cardiovascular event prevention

Side Effects: Headache, abdominal pain, constipation, nausea, eczema, insomnia, UTI

Warnings: hypersensitive to drugs, non-high risk patients w/ pregnancy, myopathy

1 Drug Name: Depakote

Generic Name: Divalproex sodium

Dosage Range: 30-500 mg/day

How to take: By mouth

Uses: Seizures, bipolar, migraines

Side Effects: headache, nausea, vomiting, dizziness, diarrhea,  
abdominal pain, insomnia, depression

Warnings: Hepatotoxicity, risk of liver failure, could  
cause congenital malformations, life threatening  
pancreatitis

2 Drug Name: Abilify

Generic Name: Aripiprazole

Dosage Range: 2-30 mg/day

How to take: By mouth

Uses: Schizophrenia, bipolar, major depression disorder

Side Effects: Headaches, weight gain, anxiety, insomnia,  
nausea, vomiting, dizziness, constipation

Warnings: Increase of suicidality, increase mortality  
risk in elderly

7 Drug Name: Neurotonin

Generic name: Gabapentin

Dosage Range: Capsuls - 100-400mg, tablets, 600-800mg,  
Solution - 50mg/mL

Uses: Seizures, Post-herpetic neuralgia,  
neuropathic Pain, Fibromyalgia, alcohol  
dependence

How to take: By mouth

Side Effects: Dizziness, fatigue, nausea, vomiting,  
Diarrhea, infection, headache, constipation

Warnings: avoid alcohol, depression, drug abuse

8 Drug name: Prilosec

Generic name: Omeprazole

Dosage Range: Capsuls 10-40mg, Granules, 10mg/packet

How to take: By mouth or gastric tube

Uses: Gastric ulcer, duodenal Ulcer, hypersecretory  
conditions, H. pylori infection,

Side Effects: Headaches, abdominal pain, nausea,  
diarrhea, vomiting,

Warnings: Poor metabolizer, long term use, high dose  
use, hypomagnesemia

5 Drug name: levothyroxine

Generic name: Euthyrox, Levothroid, Levoxyl,  
Synthroid, Thyquidity, Triosint,  
Unithroid,

Dosage Range: 13-500 mcg

uses: Hypothyroidism, TSH suppression, myxedema coma

How to take: by mouth, unless in coma, then IV  
is needed

Side Effects: Appetite increase, nervousness, weight loss,  
Diarrhea, abdominal cramps, insomnia

Warnings: hypersensitive to drugs, and by mouth forms  
of glycerol, thyrotoxicosis, adrenal insufficiency  
TSH suppression & pre-existing

6 Drug name: Anidra

Generic Name: Insulin Glulisine


Dosage Range: ~~100~~ 100 units/mL.

How to take: IV in spinal cord

Side Effects: Rash, weight gain, influenza, hypoglycemia

uses: Diabetes,

Warnings: Beware of infection, illness, stress, renal  
impairment



9 Drug Name: Toprol

Generic name: metoprolol succinate

Dosage Range: 25-400 mg

How to take: By mouth

Uses: HTN, angina, heart failure, migraines

Side Effects: Fatigue, dizziness, diarrhea, rash,  
Depression, nightmares

Warnings: Sick sinus syndrome, heart failure,  
Severe A/D

10 Drug name: ~~Wakrona~~ Norco

Generic name: hydrocodone, acetaminophen

Dosage Range: 5-325 mg

How to take: By mouth

Uses: Pain

Side Effects: Lightheadedness, dizziness, nausea,  
vomiting, constipation, drowsiness

Warnings: Asthma, circulatory shock, CVS depression,  
renal impairment


