Soap note pick apart

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**S-** Patient presents today with complaints of a strong odor coming from her urine, patient also states that her right leg is “achy” mostly in the knee area. Patient is requesting SBE education as she stated that she felt a soreness in her left breast and has a cousin that was diagnosed with breast cancer.

**O-** Per provider order: vitals were obtained (see vitals tab). Patient was educated on how to leave a CCMS urine sample. 20mL of urine was obtained from the patient and used to run a manual UA with Clinistrip Reagent Strips (Lot# U167831 Exp: 10/2022)(see results in diagnostics tab). Drew 4mL of whole blood from right AC space using the ETS method into a gold top tube, to obtain 0.5mL serum to run a Uric Acid test. Sample was prepared for transport to the lab. Patient was educated on how to perform a SBE (see patient education tab)

**A-** Patient tolerated blood draw well, no redness or irritation were observed at the site of the draw, minimal bleeding observed, but subsided with pressure. Patient verbalized and demonstrated understanding of SBE education. Patient had no questions or concerns at this time.

**P-** Patient is in exam room one waiting to speak to the provider.
