O: Per providers orders: vitals taken (see tab) pt educated on CCMS and gave enough urine for UA, also preformed blood draw syringe for 4mL of whole blood using R AC, transferred into gold top tube.

S: 44-year-old female presents today with C/O strong urine odor X4 days. Pt also states, "my left leg has been achey." Pt reports that the pain stems from her left medial tibia and has been ongoing for the past 2 weeks with pain levels ranging between 4-7. Pt rates her pain today at a 5.

O: Per Provider Order: Obtained VS, please see VS tab. Provided Pt education on standard procedure for CCMS. Performed UA using Multistix, Lot #: T198-332, Exp Date: 12/2020. Please see Lab Results for UA results. Per office protocol, provided Pt with SBE education. Please see education tab for details on both CCMS and SBE education. Also, drew 4 mL of whole blood from the Right AC, using the syringe method. Then transferred whole blood sample into a gold top tube, Lot #: 3980A, Exp Date: 30 April 2021, to obtain 0.5mL of serum, to run X test. Prepared for transport. See requisitions for lab results.

A: Pt was able to provide an adequate urine sample. Pt also verbalized understanding of CCMS and SBE education. Upon provider's palpation of left medial tibia, Pt expressed extreme tenderness and reported an increased level of pain to a 7. Otherwise, Pt handled the procedures and examination with no difficulties.

P: Pt has checked out of the office. Lab to forward results to office. Provider to call the Pt with results.
