




FOCUS

- *When the camera app on the iPhone launches, the app automatically focuses the camera lens.*
- *To manually focus the lens, use your finger to tap on the screen and the camera will focus on the object.*
- *If you like how the camera is focusing simply hold down on the center of the yellow box to AE/AF lock, so the camera won't lose focus on what you want*




EXPOSURE

- *Exposure is placed in the exact location as the yellow box used for focusing.*
- *As soon as the app launches, the camera is adjusting the exposure automatically.*
- *Exposure can be controlled manually by holding down on the yellow box then proceeding to slide your finger up and down.*




FLASH CONTROL

- *By tapping the lighting bolt icon above the camera frame it reveals the flash control settings.*
- *Control the flash by selecting auto, on, or off.*



SOUND CONTROL

- *To control the sound the camera makes switch the ringer on the side of the phone to ring for sound or silent.*
- *Keep in mind that when the iPhone is in live mode, the camera will remain silent.*




GRID LINES

- *The setting for grid lines can not be found in the camera app. The setting for grid lines can be found in the settings app under camera.*
- *Select to either turn on or off the grid lines.*




ZOOM

- *Digital zoom operates by pinching the screen to get a closer shot. The photo appears as a large cropped image.*
- *Unfortunately, while using the digital zoom the quality of the camera begins to worsen the more you zoom in*




PORTRAIT

- *Portrait mode captures excellent quality photos. Portrait mode focuses on the object while blurring everything else surround it.*
- *This mode also allows you to select the depth effect.*




PANORAMA

- *To locate the panorama setting swipe left until “PANO” appears*
- *Panorama will start once by tapping the white button, then slowly move the phone from left to right.*
- *Panorama captures horizontally elongated shots.*



- *To access slow motion videos swipe right until you land on “SLO –MO.”*
- *Slow motion gives you the luxury to capture moments longer and edit the interval for the slo-mo effect.*

TIME-LAPSE

- *Time-Lapse is found by swiping right, until a red button appears.*
- *A time-lapse video is the exact opposite of a slow-motion video.*
- *These videos allows for the time to be condensed in selected intervals.*
