20 Judicial circuits

67 County courts

As an overview for the district court of appeals it represents the final appellate review of litigated cases

An overview of the judicial courts they have jurisdiction over matters not assigned by statute to the county courts and also hear appeals from county court cases

As an overview of the 67 county courts, the Florida constitution established that there should be 1 court in each of the 67 counties in the state, it is often referred to as the peoples court.
