Bookshare


An eBook library where online volunteers help edit and scan books.


Zooniverse


Zooniverse is a site comprised of virtual volunteers around the globe who indulge in powerful research.




Smithsonian Digital Volunteer




OpenMRS


Student Science Tutor






Operation Photo Rescue
