

Vocabulary to define for Chapter 9 (Exploring Public Speaking)

1. **Presentation aids:** the resources beyond the speech itself that a speaker uses to enhance the message conveyed to the audience
2. **Olfactory:** of or relating to the sense of smell
3. **Gustatory:** of or relating to the sense of taste
4. **Chart:** graphical representation of data (often numerical) or a sketch representing an ordered process
5. **Graph:** a pictorial representation of the relationships of quantitative data using dots, lines, bars, pie slices, and the like
6. **Line graph:** a graph designed to show trends over time
7. **Bar graphs:** a graph designed to show the differences between quantities
8. **Pie graphs:** a graph designed to show proportional relationships within sets of data
9. **Pictographs:** a graph using iconic symbols to dramatize differences in amounts
10. **Tone:** the attitude of a given artifact (humorous, serious, light-hearted, etc.)
