1. Neolithic Age is a period of prehistoric existence between (ca.8000-4500BC). A civilization of people centered on the Tigris-Euphrates river system and a few other spots like Jericho and Ugarit in the Levant. Also known as the Stone Age. The group this age developed were the Mesopotamians.
2. Chalcolithic Age is a period between (4500-3000). The people identified in this period were the Sumerians. These people developed the first time independently observable culture concentrated on the Persian Gulf at the mouth of the Tigris and Euphrates River. The culture used copper extensively. Also, they were great in ceramics and literature.
