

Moses relationship with God was not like his relationship with other prophet. God didn't speak to Moses in dreams, He spoke direct to Moses. He spoke to Moses in a manner that was clear. God even allowed Moses to see him Exodus (33:18 to Exodus 34:7). His responsibility to the Israelites was for Moses to return back to Egypt and lead God's people out of slavery, and bring them to the Promised Land. God had made Moses responsible for all his houses- that is, for all the Israelites (God's people). He gave them his law by means of Moses. He led them through the desert by means of Moses. He taught them how they should live by means of Moses. He showed them how to worship to give honour to God by means of Moses. Moses the servant of the Lord died in the land of Moab, according to the word of the Lord. His death took place before Israel entered the land of promise. He was buried by God and his sepulcher is unknown.
