

From the Book of Exodus:

The **tabernacle** consisted of two chambers—the Holy of Holies and the Holy Place.

In one paragraph each, describe the following and give the Scripture references.

1 and 2. The holy of holies -The dimensions were 15x15 feet a perfect cube The holy place – The dimensions were 15x15x30 both of these locations are in the same building they are just different rooms. The sides and rear were made of thick planks and were bound by horizontal bars. The top were covered by cloths and animal skin draped over the sides and back to the ground. The holy of holies and the holy place were separated by a veil suspended on a row of pillars. The veil was made up of 4 different types of fabric; blue, purple, scarlet and white and had embroidered images of cherubim on it. Exodus 25

3. The table – The table was 2 cubits and a half long and was made of acacia wood. It had an overlay that was made of pure gold with gold molding. There were 4 gold rings at each of the four corners to hold the poles used to carry the table with. The platters and dishes were made of pure gold The bread of the presence was put on this table to be before God at all times. Exodus 25:23-30

4. The lampstand – The lampstand was made of pure gold and the base and shaft were made into flower like cups. There were six branches that extended from the lampstand and 3 cups, the shape of almond flowers with buds and blossoms are to be on one branch, there on the next branch. There were all together 7 lamps. Their wick trimmers were of pure gold as well. Exodus 25:31-40

5. Altar of incense – The dimensions of this altar was $7\frac{1}{2} \times 7\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ feet. It was made of wood, however it was covered with a bronze plate. The bronze plate was to protect it from being set fire. Horns were visible on every corner. There were rings at these corners as well allowing it to be covered. The horns signified strength, and favored a bull horns. Exodus 25-30

6. Bronze basin – This was an object used for washing. It was located between the tabernacle of meeting and the altar. Water was put in it so that Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet in water from it. Before they go in the tabernacle and upon exiting they used this basin to wash with water. Exodus 29

7. Altar for burned offerings – The altar was 5 x5 cubits long and made out of Acacia wood. It was hollow and made out of boards. Each corner had a horn that was one piece with the altar. The altar had a bronze overlay. A grating was made out of bronze for it. It was placed under the ledge of the altar so that it is halfway up the altar. The poles were made out of the same wood with the same bronze overlay. The poles were inserted into the rings.
