List the 5 Major Prophets

The five major prophetic books of the bible are Isaiah, Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, and Daniel.

1. What nation did they prophesy to?

Isaiah prophesied to the Jews in Judea. Jeremiah prophesied to the Jews in Judea and captivity.

In Lamentations Jeremiah prophesied to the Jews in Babylonian captivity. Ezekiel prophesied to Jews in Babylonian captivity. Daniel prophesied to Jews in captivity in Babylon, and gentile kings.

2. Name one major challenge they faced?

3. When did they prophesy (under what king or year)?

List the 12 minor prophets

The minor prophets Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi.

What nation did they prophesy to?

Hosea prophesied to the northern kingdom of Israel and mostly Ephraim. Joel prophesied to the Israelites in Judah. Amos prophesied to the northern kingdom of Israel. Obadiah prophesied to Edom its destruction and to Judah its restoration. Jonah prophesied to Nineveh. Micah prophesied to corrupt rulers, priest, and false prophets. Nahum prophesied to Nineveh. Habakkuk prophesied to Assyrians and Judah, Zephaniah prophesied to leaders of Jerusalem, Haggai prophesied to the Israelites during rebuilding after Babylonian exile, Zachariah prophesied to the Israelites during the rebuilding of the temple after Babylonian exile, and Malachi prophesied to Israelites after Babylonian exile.
