

## **Clear and Critical Thinking**

## **Introduction**

Throughout the educational endeavors of students in the University system in the United States there is a constant need to change and evolve in the way that learners think. In various institutions there is an emphasis in clear and critical thinking. In order to understand the importance of critical thinking there needs to be an understanding of what is the definition of critical thinking. According to researchers critical thinking is defined as the capacity to compare ideas, examine their significance, subject the information to a polite skeptic analysis, to weigh them in relation to other opposite points of view, to build argumentation systems that would support and give them coherence and to adopt a position on the basis of these structures.<sup>1</sup> In simple words critical thinking is the ability to compare ideas, data and research while examining information to form new ideas. Critical thinking on a master's level focuses on the connecting older ideas, and theories with new ideas based on the information received through research. In order for the ideas to be understood there needs to be clear and concise thinking. For this assignment learners will examine clear and critical thinking between undergraduate students and military personnel. However there first must be an understanding of what critical thinking really means.

## **Clear and Critical Thinking**

Clear and critical thinking is essential on a master's level learning and every aspect of life on a personal and professional level. Critical thinking does not refer to the accumulation of information, but the development of the ability to process information.<sup>2</sup> Learners may believe

that critical thinking is about arguing or forming a new opinion, however clear critical thinking involves analysis, synthesis and evaluation of the information presented. Critical thinking can also be seen as a way of dealing with and solving problems based on a convincing argument that is coherent, logical and rational.<sup>3</sup> Though critical thinking does not identify itself with logic, the two can be mistaken. As previously mentioned clear critical thinking is utilized in one's professional and individual development. In order to visual critical thinking researchers utilized a method called concept mapping to facilitate critical thinking. Concept mapping, graphically depicting the structure of complex concepts, is based on the observation that pictures and line drawings are often more easily comprehended than the abstract words that represent complex concepts.<sup>4</sup> The visual representation of what critical thinking puts into perspective the ability to think clearly and present complex ideas in a visual setting. It should be noted that critical thinking is not the ability to repeat the same information that is presented, but the individual should seek to adapt, fuse and utilize the information to form a new thought to have a positive result in your favor. By utilizing the technique of concept mapping student are able to put into practice and visually see the difference in their thinking that allow them to make better decisions.<sup>5</sup> It is needless to say that critical thinking for students is an essential tool that will be utilized not only in classes, but in the real world as well.
