Scandura (2019)

recommends that a leader use all the people within their organization and seek their input on areas that may be seen to require change because employees may look at the challenges on the ground better than leaders.

Holder (2016) suggests that the leader implements changes that need to happen but still make sure that uniqueness and peoples demands are kept intact, and no integrity is compromised in the process.

Within the one-year the company needs to use diagnostic tools to identify the necessity for change, take doing this will give them time to find out if people would be needed for change and how many people willing to support the change , if there is resistance, find out how to go about handling it as it may present itself and make sure all the necessary measures are put into consideration before concluding on the need for change. Hodges and Gill (2015) recommend that an organization needs to distinguish the pros and cons of making changes within the organization as any change would interfere with the history and the authenticity of the company.

Change takes place in different paces and covers different magnitudes of dimensions; sometimes change occurs is a way that the entire systems need to bring into consideration ways to figure out and change the way the organization as a whole operates. Senior and Swales (2010) when radical change is needed, it is sometimes characterized by environmental demands and leave no room for opinions and personal judgments. At other time change requires just small changes to meet the demands of emerging markets and to solve some minor issues within the

organization, this type of changes calls for just people to readjust and meet the environmental requirements.

Scandura (2019) recommends that all stakeholder be involved in giving input of any change situation that may be taking place before the change is initiated because it helps the organization in producing the best kind of change. To do these, the organizations need to make sure that they are meeting the demands of their consumers and incorporate them with the needs of all the other consumers which will help in making sure that all shareholders have input on the need for change.
