## JD'S 30-DAY BIBLE READING PLAN

### Introduction

This 30-day redemption-focused Bible reading plan must guide readers through the Scriptures with the intent the Holy Spirit will illumine the reader's understanding regarding these five subjects. The subjects are: Nature and Being of God, The Persons and Character of God, The Creation and Fall of Humanity through the First Adam, The Salvation and Redemption of Humanity through Jesus Christ the Last Adam, and finally, Proof I Have Experienced the New Creation in Christ Jesus? These subjects are inter-related as it relates to issues of salvation and must not be interpreted separately.

Therefore, I have decided to begin this Bible reading plan with the nature and character of God because the redemption of Adam and his seed is necessary because of the nature and character of God. Secondly, perhaps the Lord will illumine the mind of the reader to see the grace of God in Jesus the Christ for what it is: the saving activity of the unified Godhead that obtained eternal salvation for his people, who are manifested as being in Christ, living lifestyles of imperfect servitude to their new master Jesus the Christ.

Please note: This reading plan has specimen passages and is not exhaustive.

1. The Nature and Being of God – The nature and being of God speaks to the attributes that distinguish the Deity from his creation. It is the stuff that makes “the Deity” God-Nature. Jehovah is the name of the Deity, and God describes the nature of his being.
  - a. Day 1
    - i. God is Eternal – Deut. 33:27; Ps. 90:2, 102:25-27; Heb. 1:11-12
    - ii. God is Omniscient – Psalm 147:5; Is. 40:28; 1John 3:20

iii. God is Omnipresent – Ps. 139: 7-10; Prov. 15:3; Jer. 23:23-24;

i. God is Holy – Ps. 99:5; Is. 6:3, 57:15; 1Pet. 1:16

ii. God is a God of Justice (God is Just) – Ex. 34:7 (Will not clear the guilty); Prov. 11:1; Deut. 32:4

iii. God is Righteous – Ps. 11:7; Acts 17:31; 1Pet. 2:23

c. Day 3:

i. God is Love – 1John 4:7-8, 4:16; Gal. 5:22

ii. God is Gracious – Ex. 34:6; Ps. 145:8; Joel 2:13

iii. God is Merciful – Ex. 34:6; Ps. 116:5, 145:8-9;

d. Day 4:

i. God's is Perfection – Sin Free (Light) 1John 1:5

1. His Ways - Ps. 18:30

2. His Overall Nature - Matt. 5:48

3. His Law – Ps. 19:7

e. Day 5:

i. God exists in three Persons, a Trinity – Deut. 6:4 (Plurality of Oneness);

1John 5:7;

2. The Persons and Character of God – The God of the Holy Scriptures exists as three separate/distinct persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. Each Person of the Godhead has the characteristics of the nature and being of God.
  - a. Day 6:
    - i. Gen. 1:26-27; Deut. 6:4
  - b. Day 7
    - i. The Father is God – Matt. 11:27; 1Cor. 8:6; 2 Cor. 1:3
  - c. Day 8
    - i. The Son (the Second Person of the Godhead) is God – John 1:1,14, 8;58; Heb. 1:8; John 8:14:8-9 (Same God nature)
  - d. Day 9
    - i. The Holy Spirit is God – Acts 5:3-4; (the Eternal Spirit)-Heb. 9:14; Job 33:4
  - e. Day 10
    - i. God is his nature, and there is none like him, but Jehovah is his name
      1. None like or beside the LORD – Duet. 4:35; 1Sam. 2:2, 22:32; Is. 43:10, 45:5
      2. Jehovah is his name – Ex. 6:2-3; Ps. 83:18
3. The Creation and Fall of Humanity through the First Adam
  - a. Day 11
    - i. God Creates Adam free from Sin – Spiritually Alive – Fellowship With God - Gen. 1:26-31, 2:18-25

- ii. God Commands Adam and Warns Adam not to Eat from the Tree of the knowledge of Good and Evil. – Gen. 2:7-9,15-17

b. Day 12

- i. Adam Eats from the Tree and Falls into Sin – Becomes Spiritually Dead – Gen. 3:1-13, Rom. 5:12, 1Cor 15:21a,22a

c. Day 13

- i. God Judges Adam, Adam's Wife, and the Satan/Serpent

- 1. The Serpent – Gen. 3:14-15

- 2. The Woman – Gen 3:16

- 3. Adam – Gen. 3:17-19

- a. The Seed of Adam is Born Spiritually Dead /separated from God / after the fallen image of Adam. – Gen 3:20-24, 5:1-3

d. Day 14

- i. When Adam Fell into Sin Creation (All God Created within Time and Space) Fell into Sin – Gen. 3:1-13; Rom. 8:18-22

e. Day 15 (Reviewing and Applying Day 11's Readings)

- i. The Creation and Birth Paradigm

- 1. God created Adam and all of humanity in him as a part of his body on the sixth day.

- ii. All of humanity sinned when Adam sinned being one with him as the seed of Adam when he fell. – Gen. 3:1-13, Rom. 5:12, 1Cor 15:21a,22a

- a. People are born according to the will of God the Father at his ordained time. i.e., We were created in Adam over 5,000 plus years ago but born 1974.
4. The Salvation and Redemption of Humanity through Jesus Christ the Last Adam
- a. Day 16
    - i. The Prophets Foretold of Jesus' Coming - Gen. 3:15, Is. 7:14, 9:6-7, 52:13-53:12
  - b. Day 17
    - i. Jesus Fulfills the Prophecies Concerning His Coming
      - 1. Jesus' Birth - Matt.1:22-23; Luke 1:31-35
      - 2. Jesus' Death – Matt. 27:1-66; Mark 15:1-41; Luke 23:13-49; John 19:1-37
  - c. Day 18
    - i. Jesus Fulfills the Prophecies Concerning his Resurrection from the Dead – Matt. 28:1-15; Mark 16:1-8; Luke 24:1-12; John 20:1-10
    - ii. Declared to be God in Human Flesh with Authority/Power – John 20:1-24; Rom. 1:1-4
  - d. Day 19
    - i. Jesus Appears to his Disciples – Matt. 28:16-20; Mark 16:14-18; Luke 24:36-49; 1 Cor 15:1-8
  - e. Day 20

- i. Jesus Ascended to the Right Hand of the Father and is Coming Back Again – Acts 1:1-11; 7:55-56; Eph. 1:20; Col. 3:1; Heb. 1:3, 8:1, 10:12, 12:2
- 5. The Mechanics of the Salvation and Redemption from God through the Second Adam Jesus the Christ – This section of the reading plan focuses on how God the Father manifests his gracious gift to those he has given to the Son, the Lord Jesus Christ.
  - a. Day 21 – Salvation is All of Grace, All of God, All of Christ, not of Works lest Anyone attempt to Take Credit. God initiates, calls, justifies, and
    - i. All of Grace: Eph. 2:1-10
    - ii. All of God: Rom. 8:29-30; 1 Cor. 1:30-31
    - iii. All of Christ: John 6:44, 14:6;
  - b. Day 22 – God’s Declaration of Man’s (The Seed of the First Adam) Spiritual Condition Necessitates the New Birth. Man is unable to initiate reconciliation with God the Father because he is spiritually dead.
    - i. Gen. 3:20-24; 5:1-4
  - c. Day 23 – Salvation is the Work of God. God the Father Already Initiated the Reconciliation of Man to Himself before the Foundation of the World.
    - i. Eph. 1:3-5; Rom. 8:29-30
  - d. Day 24 –Jesus Declared: You Must Be Born Again.
    - i. John 3:1-10
  - e. Day 25 – When Spiritually Alive God Will Cause His Elect to:
    - i. You to Repent of Your Sins and Turn to God through Believing on Jesus Christ – 1 Thes. 1:4-6,9-10

- ii. The Holy Spirit will cause people to submit to the Gospel of God – Rom. 1:1,5-6
  - iii. Receive Jesus – John 1:10-14
  - iv. Confess the Lord Jesus – Rom. 10:9-11
- f. Day 26 – A Christian’s New Heart is Manifest in the Way of (Part 1)
- i. Renouncing from the heart all self-will and self-serving as the governing principle of my life. Moreover, today I am still imperfectly living a lifestyle of doing so.

- g. Day 27 – A Christian’s New Heart is Manifested in the Way of (Part 2)
- i. Renouncing from the Heart the Mastery and Practice of Sin as a Pattern of Life. Moreover, today I am still imperfectly living a lifestyle of doing so.
    - 1. Rom. 6, 8:1-8; Eph. 2:1-6
  - ii. Renouncing from the heart the world as the molding influence of my life. Moreover, today I am still imperfectly living a lifestyle of doing so.
    - 1. Titus 2:11-13; James 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17
- h. Day 28 – Find a Bible-Believing/Teaching Church So You Can Be Encouraged To Love and Do Good Works
- i. Eph. 4:11-13; Col. 3:16; Heb. 10:24-25
- i. Day 29 – The Believer’s War with Remaining Sin

- j. Day 30 – Learn the Gospel and Share the Gospel
