

Job Title: True Disciple of Jesus Christ

Description: The Faith First Fellowship is looking to fill the position of a True Disciple of Jesus Christ. This position calls for a lifetime of dedication and commitment of living a life under the guidance, tutelage and submission of Jesus the Christ and His word by the dictates of the Holy Spirit. This is imperative because as a disciple your words as well as your deeds must be in

alignment with the word of God. Your words and your deeds will be the catalyst that continues the developmental process of a Christian convert from infancy into spiritual maturity. Just as God Commanded Adam and Eve to be fruitful and multiply, the disciple will help an individual in their transformation into the likeness of Christ allowing them to continue the process.

Duties and Responsibilities: The duties and the responsibilities of the disciple are manifold. Commitment to the programs of the church such as worship services and the teaching programs. Being a disciple of Jesus Christ has nothing to do with one's educational background, but one's willingness to be committed to a life of instruction of God's word by the teaching of another disciple. A life of prayer for guidance and how to live out the principles of the word of God. The greatest of educational requirements is to have a willingness to be taught. Submitting to their disciple with a willingness to reproduce his teachings and lifestyle.

Job Skills: The disciple must be able to clearly communicate the message of Jesus Christ. Therefore, they must understand the culture and background of those they have been called to disciple. The disciple must be a good listener to hear and understand the instructions of the one leading them as well as hear the Holy Spirit speaking through the scriptures and the earthly teacher.

Character Traits: Being a disciple of Jesus Christ is a lifelong commitment, therefore the disciple must be a devoted, responsible, and submissive to being taught as well challenged and chastised. Those that Jesus called to discipleship were required to deny themselves by surrendering mind, body and soul to Christ. This person must be willing to sacrifice his/her life to take on the characteristics of Jesus. The disciple must be a person of love, having love for God as well as his fellowman. Individuals who desire the position of disciple must also have level of humility understanding they have been set apart to a life of service, for it not about them but the ones they serve, being God and fellowman.
