

Week 11 Reflection Paper

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I value one-on-one care in our church. The reason is well organized. Why do you have parenting first? One-on-one care can cure individual problems that can be hidden in the community.

It is also a great advantage of one-on-one nurturing while praying for one-on-one difficulties.

You can not see the real picture of people when you meet in a community in the church. I know it superficially. It is surrounded by many people, but there are times when it is difficult to know who should be helped when problems arise. One-on-one is that we have the caregivers who are absolutely necessary at this time, so we can pray together and solve the problem. There is a price to pay in order to solve these problems, find a way, and move on to a rich life. Sometimes in a one-on-one relationship personal freedom and privacy may be violated. However, the person who pays for it obviously follows a remarkable reward. That is when we find the right path to trouble, we get reward for the rich life of Christ-centered.

Characteristics of one-to-one discipleship

- 1) The Holy Spirit is doing. (Do not be afraid)
- 2) Bible study, not life sharing.
- 3) Those who have not completed the companion course can not be raised as caregivers.
- 4) One-on-one discipleship should be faithful to the purpose and nature of the textbook.
- 5) It is a program for carers.
- 6) You have to keep childcare period (4-6 months). (Do not finish in a short time)
- 7) The companion must be reproduced as a caregiver.

What is being a caregiver?

- 1) One-on-one care is important. God has made you a one-to-one caregiver.

2) There is nothing more exciting than changing a person. God wants you to use Him to change others. Someone is waiting for you.

3) Raising a companion is the greatest chance of life. Do not reject when opportunities are given.

4) The best way to teach is to stick to teaching materials. If you faithfully follow the textbooks, God will do the rest.

5) I am scarce. But the Holy Spirit can do it together.

6) The teacher always looks bigger. Do not be afraid. As a one-to-one caregiver, you are a precious person.

How to Parenting

1) Do this for preparation.

① Please prepare with prayer.

② Do not be afraid. The Holy Spirit is with you.

③ Do not think that you will be working today as you always do.

④ Prepare an answer for the expected question.

⑤ Do practical things together.

Prayer - prayer hall, night, fasting prayer

Conduction - Noise conduction, Axial evacuation, etc.

Fellowship - Practical fellowship (meal, movie viewing)

2) Do this when teaching content.

① Think of a good way to communicate effectively.

② Easy.

- ③ When a proclamation is needed, declare it seriously and exhort it.
 - ④ Make sure there is no leap in the development of content.
 - ⑤ Do not think that your companion knows all the easy contents.
 - ⑥ Find important Bible texts together.
 - ⑦ Do not boast your knowledge.
 - ⑧ Do not spread too much.
 - ⑨ Please handle contents carefully.
- 3) Do this when sharing.
- ① The caregiver alone Do not talk too long.
 - ② Do not interrupt the horse.
 - ③ Please listen carefully.
 - ④ Do not give too much advice.
 - ⑤ It is also helpful to have your own testimony if necessary.
- 4) You need to ask questions.
- ① Do not ask too broadly (together) and ask precisely the focus.
 - ② Ask questions in a practical and concrete way.
- 5) Do this when asked.
- ① Do not panic.
 - ② Be honest. Answer that you do not know.
 - ③ Make a good distinction between the types of questions.
- If you need an objective answer
 - If you need a subjective answer
- 6) Check the spiritual condition of your companion

You should check your partner's daily training and priorities to determine the level of your partner's spiritual status.

① Daily Devotional Time - Share a weekly cutie. Checking through cut notes is also good.

② Recitation of the Bible - Review the memorized passages together and share the newly recited verses.

③ Sunday sermon record - Write briefly in the sermon notes section of the one-on-one manual.

④ Preparation for one-on-one teaching materials - Find the required Bible in advance and write it in the textbook.

⑤ Check the key picture at any time.

7) Do this at the finish.

It is better to finish with prayer. I will summarize the key content of today and explain it together and pray that I can practice it in my life. The carer and his companion share prayer topics together, hold hands and pray together. I promise to meet next and end with warm heart and expectation.
