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1. Interpathic Caring – Knowing what others are in need of and making it happen.
2. Empowerment- authority or power given to someone to do something.
3. Dehumanization- the process of depriving a person or group of positive human qualities.
4. Liberation Theology- a movement in Christian theology developed mainly by latin American Roman Catholics, that emphasize liberation from social, political, and economic oppression as an anticipation of ultimate salvation.

6. Prisonization – Involves the formation of an informal inmate code and develops from both the individual characteristic of inmates and institutional features of the prison.

7. Punitive Forgiveness - The prison system neglect forgiveness and programs.
8. Recidivism – the tendency of a convicted criminal to reoffend.
9. Substantial Evil- A large size or amount of evil.
