- safety needs: physical safety, as well as economic, are required to live a peaceful life love and belonging these needs start developing in a person since childhood. People make and maintain significant relationships, such as friendship, family, and intimacy.
- Esteem: this need represents the urge of a person to feel respected and valued.
- Self-actualization: this kind of need refers to the realization of a person's potential about themselves.

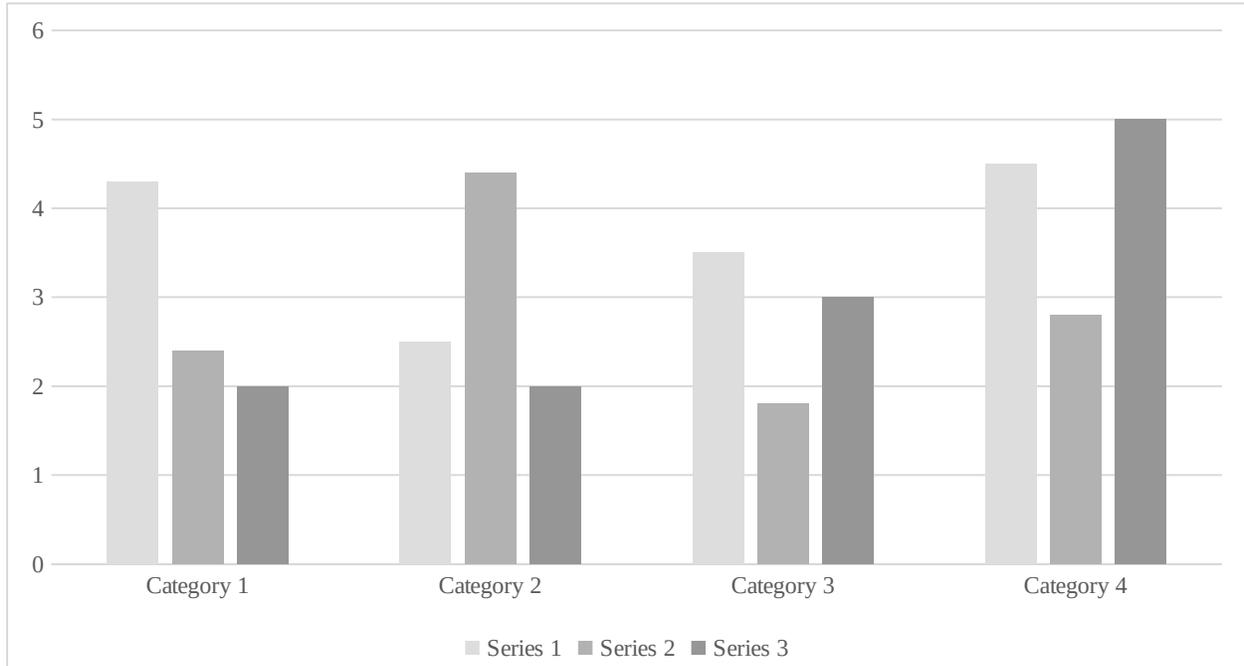
