

Contact Precautions Level III


(In addition to Standard Precautions)

Visitors – Report to Nurse’s Station **BEFORE** Entering Room

1. PATIENT PLACEMENT

Private Room

Closed



Visitors restricted until cleared by Infection Prevention.

Isolation can **ONLY BE DISCONTINUED** by the Infection Prevention Team.

2. **GLOVES - Required to enter room.** Pay special attention to extend gloves over of isolation gown cuff. Remove gloves before leaving room. Perform hand hygiene.
-
3. **GOWNS – Required to enter room.** Use **Surgical** gown when entering the room. Carefully remove gown by peeling down away from shoulders turning contaminated outside towards inside and roll into a bundle and discard in trash can before leaving room. Once removed, gowns cannot be re-used.

4. **SPECIAL PPE – Required to enter room.** Wear impervious disposable **pants and shoe coverings** when entering the room. Carefully remove PPE and avoid contaminating yourself before leaving room.
-
5. **HANDWASHING –** Perform hand hygiene only with soap and water after removing all PPE.
- Do not use alcohol hand rub for hygiene.**
After initial washing, cleans hands and wrists with scabidical hand cleanser*
-
6. **TRANSPORTING –** Limit the movement /transport of patient from room for essential purposes only. Cover patient with clean linens during transport. Notify receiving department of isolation needs prior to transport.
-
7. **CLEANING OF ROOM –** Contact Environmental Services and Infection Prevention for special instructions on daily and terminally cleaning of room. Bed cannot be used for 48 hours after patient is discharged.
