1. Classification of Burn Injury

Superficial Partial Thickness	Deep Partial Thickness	Full Thickness

Involves the epidermis	Red, blistered, shiny, wet appearing	superficial, red
Destruction of entire dermis	involves the dermis	i.e. sunburn
i.e. electrical	whitish, charred, or translucent	i.e. scald
First Degree	Second Degree	Third Degree
